## Land, Environment and Development Project

The **LAND ENVIRONMENT AND DEVELOPMENT PROJECT** of the **Legal Assistance Centre (LAC)** invites dynamic persons to apply for the position of a candidate legal practitioner. The LAC is a public-interest law centre based in Windhoek and was established in 1988 to provide legal services to indigent individuals and communities. The LAC has a proud history of fighting human rights violations during the apartheid era and is now playing a major role in the building of a constitutional democracy and a human rights culture in Namibia.

The successful candidate:

- Must be in possession of a B. Proc or an LL. B degree from a recognised tertiary institution;
- Will have to successfully enroll for the 2022 Justice Training Course at the Justice Training Centre at the University of Namibia or must already have successfully completed the Justice Training Course.

The attachment is for 9 months. The LAC is offering an allowance for the successful candidate.

In terms of its affirmative action policy the LAC will give preference to suitably qualified women, persons from disadvantaged backgrounds and persons with disabilities.
