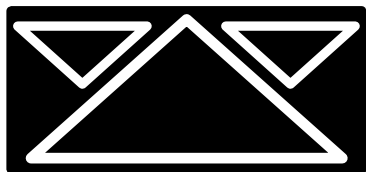

- Submit activity reports to LAC management.

The ideal candidate should meet the following requirements:

Academic:

- LLB degree or other recognized Law Degree
- The applicant must be an admitted Legal Practitioner of the High Court of Namibia

Experience:

- The ability to communicate and negotiate at all levels;
- Minimum 4 years post-admission experience
- A systematic methodical approach to work;
- The willingness and ability to travel out of town and to rural areas when required;
- Tolerance and respect for diverse viewpoints and choices.
- Good command of the English language (both written and oral) – proficiency in other languages spoken will be an advantage
- A keen interest and belief in human and constitutional rights.
