PROCLAMATION.

BY HIS HONOUR EDMOND HOWARD LACAM GORGES, A COMPANION OF THE MOST DISTINGUISHED ORDER OF SAINT MICHAEL AND SAINT GEORGE, A MEMBER OF THE ROYAL VICTORIAN ORDER, ADMINISTRATOR OF THE PROTECTORATE OF SOUTH WEST AFRICA IN MILITARY OCCUPATION OF THE UNION FORCES.

No. 1 of 1919.]

WHEREAS it is desirable to make certain amendments of the Customs and Excise Tariff heretofore in force in the Protectorate.

NOW THEREFORE under and by virtue of the powers in me vested, I do hereby declare, proclaim and make known as follows:

1. Additional customs and excise duties are hereby imposed on the articles mentioned in the Schedule hereto as specified therein as from the date hereof and are payable on all stocks of such articles held for sale in the Protectorate as at 8 a.m. on the said date.

2. Proclamation No. 6 dated 16th July 1915, Proclamation No. 15 dated 20th September 1915, Proclamation No. 9 dated 25th July 1916, Proclamation No. 6 dated 4th September 1917 and Proclamation No. 4 dated 25th June 1918, shall be and are hereby amended to the extent indicated in Section One hereof.

MARTIAL LAW REGULATION.

Regulation No. 94 issued under Martial Law by and with the approval of the Administrator.

STOCKS OF SPIRITS AND BEER HELD FOR SALE IN THE PROTECTORATE OF SOUTH WEST AFRICA.

94. Every person in the Protectorate holding for sale stocks of the articles mentioned in the schedule hereof shall not later than the twenty-eighth February, 1919 make a return to the Military Magistrate of the district showing the quantities of such articles held by him as at 8 a.m. on the twenty-fourth February, 1919.

The respective quantities shall be specified as indicated in the schedule.

Such return shall be supported by a sworn declaration by such person of its accuracy.

Any person failing duly to furnish such return or wilfully making such return falsely shall be guilty of an offence. The Court may order the cancellation of any licence held by such person.

Upon any sale, purchase or transfer of any livestock which is in either of the districts of WARMBAD or AROAB delivery of such livestock shall not take place except upon production to the seller or transferor of a permit issued hereunder for the removal of such livestock, and no person shall, whether as principal or agent, deliver or take delivery of such livestock before such production of a permit.

(7.) Notwithstanding the foregoing or any other existing provision of law no person shall move or attempt to move or assist any other person to move any cattle in the district of Grootfontein from outside the area contained within the line defined in the Schedule hereto into such area, save under a permit issued by the Military Magistrate of Grootfontein or a member of the Military Constabulary in charge of a police post in the said district.

(8.) Except for the purposes of clause (7) hereof, nothing in this regulation contained shall apply to horses, mules, donkeys or cattle being bona fide employed in drawing any vehicle or to any riding animal being bona fide employed for riding.

(9.) Any person who contravenes or attempts to evade any provision of this regulation or who incites or induces any other person so to do or who alters, counterfeits, or substitutes any permit or who fails or refuses to exhibit any permit upon demand made by any Magistrate or member of the Constabulary shall be guilty of an offence

and upon conviction shall be liable to a fine not exceeding Five Hundred Pounds or in default of payment to imprisonment with or without hard labour for a period not exceeding two years or to both such fine and such imprisonment.

(10.) In any prosecution for an offence against this regulation the burden of proof that a permit has been issued shall be upon the accused.

SCHEDULE

A line along the railway line from Otjiwarongo to Grootfontein from the point where it crosses the boundary of the district of Grootfontein to the point where it crosses the boundary of the village of Grootfontein, thence along the northerly boundaries of the said village to the point thereof nearest to the boundary of the Grootfontein commonage, thence in a straight line to the nearest point of the last mentioned boundary, thence along the northerly boundaries of the Grootfontein commonage and grazing reserve to the eastern beacon of the latter, thence in a straight line to the northern beacon of the farm Bubus, thence in a straight line to the northern boundary of the farm Dornhügel, thence along the easterly boundaries of the farms Dornhügel, 27, 18, Neufeld (or Okaljeru West), Vormdurst (or Okaljeru Ost), to the point where the boundary of the last mentioned farm reaches the police zone, thence along the police zone to the southern boundary of the district of Grootfontein, thence along the southerly boundaries of the said district to the point first mentioned.

The subscription for every number of the Gazette is six shillings per annum, post free. Single copies of the Gazette may be obtained at the price of 6d per copy.

The charge for the insertion of advertisements other than the notices mentioned in the succeeding paragraph, is at the rate of 6/- per inch single column and 12/- per inch double column, repeats half price.

Notices to creditors and debtors in the estates of deceased persons and notices by executors concerning liquidation accounts lying for inspection, are published in schedule form at 9/- per estate.
