CINEMATOGRAPHIC FILM REGULATIONS.

The Administrator has been pleased, under and by virtue of the powers vested in him by sections *three* (1), *six* and *eight* of the Cinematographic Film Ordinance, 1928 (Ordinance No. 9 of 1928), to make the following regulations:—

REGULATIONS.

1. There shall be paid to each member of the Board of Inspectors appointed under Section *three* of the Cinematographic Film Ordinance, 1928 (Ordinance No. 9 of 1928), remuneration at the rate of £1 for every day on which he attends a meeting of the Board.
2. (a) A person desiring to submit any film for examination shall give notice to that effect in writing addressed to the chairman of the Board of Inspectors.
- (b) Upon receipt of any such notice the chairman shall notify the person so desiring to submit a film for examination, of the time and place at which the Board will sit to examine the film. Such person as aforesaid shall then exhibit the film at his own expense at the time and place so fixed and provide the necessary apparatus and assistance for the proper exhibition of such film.
- (c) Such person aforementioned, when giving notice to the chairman as provided in this regulation, shall forward with such notice the Customs Certificate giving the name and length in feet of the film.
3. (a) For the purpose of examining any film submitted for approval, three members of the Board of Inspectors shall form a quorum: Provided that in order to facilitate the examination of films of a scenic, industrial, topical and educational character or other class of film designated by him, the Administrator may authorise the inspection of such films by a Committee of two members of the Board under such conditions as he may define from time to time.
- (b) The chairman, when present, shall have a deliberative but not a casting vote.
- (c) If for any reason the Board cannot come to a decision, the question shall be submitted for decision to the Administrator.
4. The certificate to be given when a film is approved by the Board shall be in the following form:—

Board of Film Inspectors (Territory of South West Africa).

5. The certificate to be given when a film is approved by the Administrator, shall be in the following form:—

Administration of the Territory of South West Africa.

6. (a) The certificate aforesaid shall be signed by the chairman of the Board or by the Secretary for South West Africa, as the case may be, or, in case of the illness or absence of the chairman, by some member of the Board chosen by the remaining members as Acting Chairman.
