PROCLAMATION

By HIS HONOUR DAVID GIDEON CONRADIE,
ADMINISTRATOR OF SOUTH WEST AFRICA.

No. 3 of 1936.]

WHEREAS it is expedient further to amend the law relating to the sale of intoxicating liquor;

NOW THEREFORE, under and by virtue of the powers in me vested, I do hereby proclaim, declare and make known as follows:—

1. Notwithstanding the date of publication thereof, the Liquor Licensing Amendment Ordinance, 1935 (Ordinance No. 14 of 1935), shall not be deemed to have come into operation until the first day of December, 1935.

2. This Proclamation may be cited for all purposes as the Liquor Licensing Law Amendment Proclamation, 1936.
