WHEREAS it is expedient to amend the law relating to prescription in the Territory;

NADEMAAL dit raadsaam is om die wet betreffende verjaring in die Gebied te wysig;

NOW THEREFORE, under and by virtue of the powers in me vested, I do hereby proclaim, declare and make known as follows:—

SO IS DIT dat ek, kragtens die bevoegdheid my verleen, hiermee proklameer, verklaar en bekendmaak, soos volg:—

1. Section three of the Prescription Proclamation, 1943 (No. 13 of 1943), hereinafter called the principal Proclamation, is hereby amended by the deletion of sub-paragraph (iv) of paragraph (b) of sub-section (2) thereof.

1. Artikel drie van die Verjaringsproklamasie, 1943 (No. 13 van 1943), hierna die Hoofproklamasie genoem, word hiermee gewysig deur subparagraaf (iv) van paragraaf (b) van subartikel (2) daarvan te skrap.

2. This Proclamation shall be called the Prescription Amendment Proclamation, 1944, and shall be deemed to have been in operation from the commencement of the principal proclamation.

2. Hierdie Proklamasie heet die Verjarings-wysigingsproklamasie, 1944 en word geag vanaf die inwerkingtreding van die Hoofproklamasie van krag te gewees het.

WHEREAS it is desirable to amend the law relating to public education;

NOW THEREFORE, under and by virtue of the powers in me vested, I do hereby proclaim, declare and make known as follows:—

1. In this Proclamation the expression "the principal proclamation" shall mean the Education Proclamation, 1926 (No. 16 of 1926), as amended from time to time.

2. Section one of the principal proclamation is hereby amended—

(a) by the addition, after the definition of "Department", of the following definition:—

"Departmental Organizer" means an officer appointed under section five bis;" and

(b) by the insertion, after the word school in the definition of "Teacher", of the words "a departmental organizer".

3. The principal proclamation is hereby amended by the insertion, after section five, of the following new section:—

Appoint-
ment of de-
partmental
organizers.

5bis. (1) The Director may from time to time, subject to the approval of the Administrator, appoint departmental organizers to assist in organizing, and to supervise, the teaching of domestic science, needlework, woodwork, metal work, art, singing, and other special subjects.

(2) Such departmental organizers shall have such powers and shall perform such duties as may be conferred or imposed upon them by this Proclamation or by regulation, or as may be assigned to them by the Director in so far as the same are not inconsistent with this Proclamation or any regulations.

(3) The scales of annual salaries for such departmental organizers shall be the scales set out in sub-section (2) of section sixty-nine, the provisions of which sub-section shall *mutatis mutandis* apply to such departmental organizers."

4. Section sixty-six of the principal proclamation is hereby amended by the deletion of the figures "1938" and the substitution therefor of the figures "1944".

5. Section sixty-seven of the principal proclamation is hereby repealed and the following section substituted therefor:—

SO IS DIT dat ek, kragtens die bevoegdheid my verleen, hiermee proklameer, verklaar en bekendmaak soos volg:—

1. In hierdie Proklamasie beteken die uitdrukking „die hoofproklamasie" die Onderwysproklamasie 1926 (No. 16 van 1926), soos van tyd tot tyd gewysig.

2. Artikel een van die hoofproklamasie word hiermee gewysig deur—

(a) die byvoeging, na die omskrywing van „Departement" van die volgende woordbepaling:—

„Departementele Organiseerder", 'n amptenaar aangestel ooreenkomstig artikel vyf bis;" en

(b) die invoeging, na die woord „skool" in die omskrywing van „Onderwyser", van die woorde „'n departementele organiseerder".

3. Die hoofproklamasie word hiermee gewysig deur die invoeging, na artikel vyf, van die volgende nuwe artikel:—

5bis. (1) Die Direkteur kan van tyd tot tyd, onderhewig aan die goedkeuring van die Administrateur, departementele organiseerders aanstel om behulpzaam te wees met die organisering van, en toesig te hou oor, die onderwys van huishoudkunde, naaldwerk, houtwerk, metaalwerk, kuns, sang en ander spesiale vakke.

(2) Sodanige departementele organiseerders het sodanige magte en moet sodanige pligte uitvoer as wat hulle deur hierdie Proklamasie of by regulasie toegeken of opgelê word, of wat hulle deur die Direkteur toegewys word, in soverre dit nie strydig met hierdie Proklamasie of enige regulasies is nie.

(3) Die skale van jaarlikse salarisse vir sodanige departementele organiseerders is die skale uiteengesit in subartikel (2) van artikel negen-en-sestig, die bepalinge waarvan *mutatis mutandis* op sodanige departementele organiseerders van toepassing is.

4. Artikel ses-en-sestig van die hoofproklamasie word hiermee gewysig deur die skraping van die syfers „1938", en die vervanging daarvan deur die syfers „1944".

"(2) The scales of annual salaries for assistant teachers in Secondary Schools graded as High Schools and in Secondary Schools not graded as High Schools employed mainly in standards above the sixth standard shall be as detailed hereunder:—

“(4) The scales of annual salaries for principal teachers of Secondary Schools not graded as High Schools shall be as detailed hereunder:—

- (a) As for principal teachers of Primary Schools with an addition of £125 per annum in the case of men and £100 per annum in the case of women where the pupils in the seventh and eighth standards combined do not number more than 40.
- (b) As for principal teachers of Primary Schools with an addition of £150 per annum in the case of men and £120 per annum in the case of women where the pupils in the seventh and eighth standards combined number more than 40 but less than 100.
- (c) As for principal teachers of Primary Schools with an addition of £175 per annum in the case of men and £150 in the case of women where the pupils in the seventh and eighth standards combined number 100 or more.”; and

(c) by the deletion of sub-section (5) and the substitution therefor of the following sub-section:—

“(5) The scales of annual salaries for principal teachers of High Schools shall be as detailed hereunder:—

9. Section eighty-four of the principal proclamation is hereby repealed.

10. Section one hundred and fifty-two of the principal proclamation is hereby amended—

- (a) by the deletion in sub-section (1) thereof of the words “pensions, travelling expenses and local allowance” and the substitution therefor of the words “pensions and travelling expenses”; and
- (b) by the deletion in sub-section (2) thereof of the words “travelling expenses and local allowance” and the substitution therefor of the words “and travelling expenses.”

8. Artikel vyf-en-sewentig van die hoofproklamasie word hiermee gewysig deur die skraping van die woorde „pensioenbydrae, pensioen en gebiedstoelae” en die vervanging daarvan deur die woorde „pensioenbydrae en pensioen”.

- (a) die skraping van die woorde „pensioene, reisonkoste en plaaslike toelae” in subartikel (1) daarvan, en die vervanging daarvan deur die woorde „pensioene en reisonkoste”; en
- (b) die skraping van die woorde „reisonkoste en plaaslike toelae” in subartikel (2) daarvan, en die vervanging daarvan deur die woorde „en reisonkoste”.

11. Section *one hundred and fifty-six* of the principal Proclamation is hereby amended by the deletion, in paragraph (c) of sub-section (1) thereof of the words "of territorial allowance and".

12. (1) The following rules shall be followed in regard to the adjustment of the salaries of teachers, who were in the service of the department at the date when this Proclamation came into force, to the new salary scales put into force by the amendments made to the principal proclamation by this Proclamation:—

A. The minimum salary on the new scale on which a teacher is entitled to be paid on the 1st April, 1944, shall be advanced by the same number of increments as were approved up to the 31st March, 1944, on the old scale on which such teacher was then paid, and such teacher's incremental date shall remain unchanged: Provided that if an incremental date falls on the 1st April, 1944, the new salary as determined under this rule shall be advanced by one increment.

B. If any teacher is promoted to a higher salary scale with effect from the 1st April, 1944, an adjustment of his salary shall first be made in accordance with rule A, as if he had in fact not been promoted, and the salary thus determined shall be the salary to be taken into account in fixing the salary, in accordance with section *seventy-seven*, on the higher scale to which he has been promoted.

C. If any teacher does not, after an adjustment of his salary under these rules has been made, benefit to the extent of at least £35 per annum, such salary shall be advanced by one increment: Provided that in calculating the said benefit any increment due on the 1st April, 1944, shall not be taken into account.

D. Notwithstanding anything to the contrary in these rules contained if any woman teacher has, on the 1st April, 1944, had at least twenty years experience gained as a teacher in primary schools, and if at least fifteen of such twenty years have been in the service of the department, such woman teacher's salary shall be adjusted to the maximum salary of the new scale applicable to her.

E. If a teacher has on the 1st April, 1944, reached the maximum salary on the old scale which was applicable to him prior to such date, such teacher shall be adjusted to the maximum salary of the new scale applicable to him: Provided that if any such new scale provides that the final increment may only be approved five years after the granting of the previous increment, and if such teacher has not served for five years on the maximum salary of such old scale, such teacher's salary shall on the 1st April, 1944, be adjusted to the salary on such new scale at the stage of such previous increment, and provided further that such teacher's salary shall after a period, calculated by deducting the period during which such teacher served on the maximum salary on such old scale from a period of five years, be adjusted to the maximum salary on such new scale.

F. Notwithstanding anything to the contrary in these rules contained, the Administrator may, on the recommendation of the Director and on considering that the circumstances of the case so warrant, approve of the salary of any teacher adjusted in terms of these rules, being advanced by one or two additional increments, even if the granting of such increment or increments would advance the salary of such teacher to a salary higher than that prescribed by law for such teacher.

(2) The Director shall decide all matters arising out of the application of the provisions of this section and his decision shall be final.

13. Section *one* of the Teachers' Pensions Proclamation, 1931 (No. 39 of 1931) as amended from time to time, is hereby amended by the deletion of the definition of "the Education Proclamation" and the substitution therefor of the following new definition:—

"the Education Proclamation' means the Education Proclamation, 1926 (No. 16 of 1926) as amended from time to time."

14. The Teachers' Pensions Proclamation, 1931 (No. 39 of 1931) as amended from time to time, is hereby amended by the insertion, after section *twenty-nine* of the following new section:—

29bis. For the purpose of this Proclamation a departmental organizer, appointed under the provisions of section *five bis* of the Education Proclamation, shall be deemed to be a teacher appointed by the Director to a post in a school established by the Administration for the instruction of European children."

"A Departmental Organizer shall be deemed to be a teacher"

11. Artikel *honderd ses-en-veertig* van die hoofproklamasie word hiermee gewysig deur die strapping van die woorde "van plaaslike toelae en" in paragraaf (q) van sub-artikel (1) daarvan.

12. (1) By die aanpassing van die salarisse van onderwysers, wat ten tyde van die inwerkingtreding van hierdie Proklamasie in die diens van die Departement was, by die nuwe salarisskaal wat in werking tree as gevolg van die wysigings wat aan die hoofproklamasie deur hierdie proklamasie aangebring is, moet die volgende reëls toegepas word:—

A. Die minimum salaris op die nuwe skaal, waarop 'n onderwyser op 1 April 1944 geregtig is om betaal te word, moet vermeerder word met dieselfde aantal verhogings wat tot op 31 Maart 1944 goedgekeur is volgens die ou skaal waarop sodanige onderwyser toe betaal is, en sodanige onderwyser se verhogingsdatum bly onveranderd: Met dien verstande dat indien 'n verhogingsdatum op 1 April 1944 val, die nuwe salaris wat onder hierdie reël vasgestel word, met een verhoging vermeerder moet word.

B. Indien 'n onderwyser tot 'n hoër salarisskaal bevorder word met ingang vanaf 1 April 1944, moet sy salaris eers in ooreenstemming met reël A vasgestel word, asof hy in werklikheid nie bevorder was nie, en die salaris, aldus vasgestel, is die salaris waarmee rekening gehou moet word by die vasstelling van die salaris, ooreenkomstig artikel *sewe-en-sewentig*, op die hoër skaal waartoe hy bevorder is.

C. Indien 'n onderwyser, na herreëling van sy salaris onder hierdie reëls, nie met minstens £35 per jaar bevoordeel word nie, moet sodanige salaris met een verhoging vermeerder word: Met dien verstande dat by berekening van sodanige voordeel enige verhoging wat op 1 April 1944 val, nie in aanmerking geneem moet word nie.

D. Ondanks enige andersluidende bepalings in hierdie reëls, moet die salaris van 'n onderwyseres, indien sy op 1 April 1944 minstens twintig jaar ondervinding in primêre skole het en minstens vyftien jaar in diens van die departement is, vermeerder word tot die maksimum salaris van die nuwe skaal wat op haar van toepassing is.

E. Indien 'n onderwyser op 1 April 1944 die maksimum salaris op die ou skaal, wat op sodanige datum op from van toepassing was, bereik het, moet sodanige onderwyser se salaris vermeerder word tot die maksimum van die nuwe skaal wat op hom van toepassing is: Met dien verstande dat, indien enige sodanige nuwe skaal daarvoor voorsiening maak dat die finale verhoging eers vyf jaar na die toekenning van die vorige verhoging goedgekeur mag word en indien sodanige onderwyser nie vir vyf jaar op die maksimum salaris van die ou skaal diens gedoen het nie, sodanige onderwyser se salaris op 1 April 1944 verhoog moet word tot die salaris op sodanige nuwe skaal op die trap van sodanige vorige verhoging, en met dien verstande verder dat sodanige onderwyser se salaris, na 'n tydperk wat bereken word deur die tydperk wat sodanige onderwyser op die maksimum salaris van sodanige ou skaal diens gedoen het, af te trek van 'n tydperk van vyf jaar, moet verhoog word tot die maksimum salaris van sodanige nuwe skaal.

F. Ondanks enige andersluidende bepalings in hierdie reëls, kan die Administrateur, op aanbeveling van die Direkteur, en indien hy van mening is dat die omstandighede van die geval dit regverdig, goedkeur dat die salaris van enige onderwyser, wat ooreenkomstig hierdie reëls vasgestel is, deur een of twee bykomende verhogings vermeerder word, selfs al sou die toekenning van sodanige verhoging of verhogings die salaris van sodanige onderwyser hoër maak as die salaris wat deur die wet vir sodanige onderwyser voorgeskryf word.

(2) Die Direkteur beslis oor alle aangeleenthede wat uit die toepassing van die bepalings van hierdie artikel mag ontstaan, en sy beslissing is final.

13. Artikel *een* van die Proklamasie van 1931 betreffende Pensioene van Onderwysers (No. 39 van 1931) soos van tyd tot tyd gewysig, word hiermee gewysig deur die omskrywing van "die Onderwysproklamasie" te skrap en dit te vervang deur die volgende nuwe woordbepaling:—

"die Onderwysproklamasie", beteken die Onderwysproklamasie 1926 (No. 16 van 1926) soos van tyd tot tyd gewysig."

14. Die Proklamasie van 1931 betreffende Pensioene van Onderwysers (No. 39 van 1931) soos van tyd tot tyd gewysig, word hiermee gewysig deur die invoeging van die volgende nuwe artikel na artikel *neg-en-twintig*:—

29bis. Vir die doeleindes van hierdie Proklamasie word 'n Departementale Organiseerder, aangestel ooreenkomstig die bepalings van artikel *vyf bis* van die Onderwysproklamasie, geag 'n onderwyser te wees, wat deur die Direkteur in 'n betrekking in 'n skool deur die Administrasie ingestel vir die onderrig van blanke kinders, aangestel is".

"n Departementale Organiseerder sal geag word 'n onderwyser te wees."

15. This Proclamation shall be called the Education Amendment Proclamation, 1944, and, with the exception of sections two, three, thirteen and fourteen which shall be deemed to have come into operation on the first day of January, 1944, shall be deemed to have come into operation on the first day of April, 1944.
