ANNEXURE.
REGULATION.AMENDMENT OF NATIONAL SECURITY REGULATION 30
(WAR MEASURE No. 4 OF 1941).

Regulation 30 of the National Security Regulations promulgated by Proclamation No. 20 of 1941, dated the 3rd day of February, 1941, as amended from time to time, is hereby amended—

- (a) by the deletion in sub-regulation (1) of the words "who was domiciled or resident in the Union or the Mandated Territory at the time when he was attested for service with those forces";
- (b) by the substitution in the said sub-regulation for the words "the Territory" of the words "the Mandated Territory";
- (c) by the substitution in the said sub-regulation for the words "so attested", wherever they occur, of the words "attested for service with those forces";
- (d) by the deletion in sub-regulation (2) of the words "who was domiciled or resident in the Union or the Mandated Territory at the time when he was attested for service with those forces";
- (e) by the substitution in the said sub-regulation for the words "the Territory" of the words "the Mandated Territory";
- (f) by the substitution in the said sub-regulation for the words "so attested", wherever they occur, of the words "attested for service with those forces"; and
- (g) by the addition at the end of the said regulation of the following sub-regulation:—

"(9) For the purposes of this regulation any member of the land, air or naval forces of the Union, who was not domiciled or resident in the Union or the Mandated Territory at the time when he was attested for service with those forces, shall be deemed to have been resident, at the time when he was so attested, at the place in the Union where the headquarters of the forces concerned is situated."

ANNEXURE.

AMENDMENT OF EMERGENCY FINANCE
REGULATIONS.

CONTROL OF CAPITAL ISSUES.

The regulations set forth in the Annexure to War Measure No. 119 of 1942 (Proclamation No. 266 of 1942), as amended by War Measure No. 9 of 1943 (Proclamation No. 30 of 1943) and by War Measure No. 14 of 1947 (Proclamation No. 59 of 1947) are hereby further amended by the substitution for sub-regulation (2) of regulation 14 of the following sub-regulation:—

"(2) The Minister of Finance may from time to time by notice in the Gazette—

(a) exempt particular classes of issuers of capital, either generally, or in respect of particular classes of issues of capital, from the operation of sub-regulation (1); or

(b) increase, either generally or in respect of particular classes of issues of capital, the aggregate exemption limits of five thousand pounds prescribed in sub-regulation (1)

and may by similar notice withdraw any such aforementioned notice or refuse to not less than five thousand pounds any exemption limit prescribed in any such aforementioned notice as the case may be."

BYLAE.

DIREKTEUR VAN VOEDSELVOORRADE EN
DISTRIBUSIE.

Grasmaats.—Rys, heel of gebreek en alle eetbare rysprodukte met inbegrip van stysel en meel en alle rysprodukte wat vir dierlike voedsel bedoel is; gars, hawer en rog en die produkte daarvan.

NOTE.—Permits issued by the Department of Agriculture are required for the importation of wheat and wheat products, maize and maize products.

Cocoa.—Cocoa beans raw, nips and shells; cocoa butter; unsweetened chocolate couverture.

Fats and Oils.—Fatty acids; fish oils; oils and fats, animal and vegetable; oil seeds, including groundnuts for edible purposes; soap and substances containing soap.

Fish.—(1) Salted cod, haddock, hake, cusk, pollock, saithe and ling; (2) canned (tinned) salmon, pilchards, sardines, herrings, sild, brislings, alewives, tuna, mackerel, crawfish and ground fish (cod, haddock, hake, cusk, pollock, saithe and ling).

Meat.—Fresh, frozen, pickled, salted, smoked, canned, and dehydrated meat (excluding fresh and frozen poultry, rabbits and venison).

Pulses.—Dry beans, dry peas, dry lentils.

CONTROLLER OF JUTE GOODS.

Jute products, whether in the piece or manufactured; bags, woolpacks and pockets, whether new or second-hand made from Jute, cotton, linen or any other fibre and suitable as containers for the conveyance of grain or grain products, wool, fruit, vegetables, fertilizers or coal; sewing and binding twine; paper lined jute or fibre material; excluding—

- (a) such other manufactured commodities containing jute as a base or ingredient such as carpets, linoleums, jute webbing, jute gasketing, jute sashcord and jute furnishing fabrics excepting hessian;
- (b) goods packed in jute or hessian covers and/or containers in respect of such covers or containers.

NOTE.—In terms of Government Notice No. 2019 of the 20th September, 1946, the above-mentioned goods are subject to import permit irrespective of the country of origin.

EXPLANATORY NOTES:

(1) The effect of this notice is to amend the previous list of articles requiring import permits under the National Emergency Regulations. Goods not shown in the above Schedule and those specifically excluded under the heading Controller of Jute Goods may be imported without permits previously required under these regulations.

(2) It should be noted that it is required by the Customs Department that importers who claim admission of permit-free goods must make and subscribe to the following certificates on the Customs Bill of Entry: "I certify that the goods marked X are not subject to import permit." (Signature).....

IMPORTANT NOTES:

Certificates of Essentiality for the importation of the following quota goods allocated to the Union by the Union Kingdom are still required and applications therefor should be submitted as heretofore:—

1. Leather.

CONTROL OF INDUSTRIAL CHEMICALS AND NON-FERROUS MATERIALS.

I, Gabriel Daniel Louw, Controller of Industrial Chemicals and Non-Ferrous Materials, on behalf of the Minister of Economic Development, and by virtue of the authority invested in me by Government Notice No. 84 of 10th January, 1947, and War Measure No. 146 of 1942, as amended, do hereby order as follows:—

PART I.—GENERAL.

1. In this notice the following words and expressions have the meanings assigned to them unless the context otherwise requires:—

"Controller" means the Controller of Industrial Chemicals and Non-ferrous Materials, whose address is 216 Central Street, Pretoria;

"Union" means the Union of South Africa and includes the Mandated Territory of South West Africa and the port and settlement of Walvis Bay.

2. The headings of the various parts of the regulations form part of the regulations.

3. The regulation shall apply throughout the Union.

4. Notwithstanding anything contained in these regulations the Controller may in such circumstances and to such extent as he may deem fit grant exemption to any person from all or any of the provisions of these regulations.

OPMERKING.—Permitte wat deur die Departement van Landbou uitgereik word, is nog nodig vir die invoer van koring en koringprodukte en mielies en mielieprodukte.

Kakao.—Kakaobone, rou, saadlyesies en bassies, kakaobutter, nie-sout gemaakte sjokolade-bekleding.

Vetstowwe en Olies.—Vetsure; visolie; diërlike en plantaardige olie en vetstowwe; olieasde met inbegrip van grondbone vir eetdoelindes; seep en stowwe wat seep bevat.

Vis.—(1) Gesoute kabeljou, skelvis, stokvis, dors, pollak, saithe en leng; (2) ingemaakte (in blikke) salm, pelsers, sardientjies, harings, sild, brisling, Amerikaanse haring, tonny, makriel, kreef en grondvis (kabeljou, skelvis, stokvis, dors, pollak, saithe en leng).

Vleisoorle.—Vars, bevrore, ingelê, gesout, gerook, blikkies en ontwater (met uitsondering van vars en bevrore pluimvee, konyne en wildvleis).

Peutergras.—Gedroogde boontjies, gedroogde ertjies, en gedroogde lensies.

KONTROLEUR VAN JUTEGOEDERE.

Juteprodukte, hetsy in die stuk of vervaardig; sakke, wolsakke en sakkies, hetsy nuut of tweedehands, gemaak van jute, katoen, linne of enige ander vesel en geskik as houters vir die vervoer van graan of graanprodukte, wol, vrugte, groente, misstowwe of steenkool; naal- en bindtouw; jute- of veselmateriaal met papier uitgevoerd; maar behalwe—

- (a) sulke ander vervaardigde kommoditeite wat jute as 'n basis of bestanddeel bevat soos tapete, linoleums, jutewefel, jutepakking, juteramkoord en jute-meubeleerstowwe met uitsondering van goeing;
- (b) goedere in jute- of goeingoortreksels en/of -housers gepak ten opsigte van sulke oortreksels of houters.

OPMERKING.—Ingevolge Goewermentskennigging No. 2019 van 20 September 1946, word 'n invoerpermit vir bovermelde goedere vereis omgang die land van herkoms.

VERDUIDELIKENDE OPMERKINGS:

(1) Die uitwerking van hierdie kennisgewing is dat die vorige lys artikels waarvoor invoerpermitte ingevolge die Landsnoodtoestandregulasies nodig was, gewysig word. Goedere wat nie in bostaande Bylae aangegee is nie en die uitsonderings wat spesiaal onder die opskrif Kontroleur van Jutegoedere genoem is, kan ingevoer word sonder permitte wat voorheen ingevolge hierdie regulasies vereis is.

(2) Daar moet opgelet word dat die Doeanedepartement vereis dat invoorders wat op toelating van permittyvye goedere aanspraak maak, die volgende verklaring op die Doeanne-inklaringsbrief moet doen en dit onderteken: "Ek sertifiseer dat die goedere wat met 'n X gemerk is, geen invoerpermit vereis nie.

EMERGENCY FINANCE REGULATIONS. CONTROL OF CAPITAL ISSUES.—EXEMPTION.

By virtue of the powers conferred upon me by Emergency Finance Regulation 14 (2), as amended, published under Proclamation No. 112 of 1947, I hereby exempt all companies and persons, other than municipalities or other local authorities, from the operation of Regulation 14 (1), published under Proclamation No. 59 of 1947, until further notice.

In view of the foregoing exemption all conditions relating directly or indirectly to fixed property which the Treasury has at any time imposed or included in any of its consents, under Regulation 14, to the issue of capital, are hereby withdrawn and cancelled.

EXPLANATORY NOTES.

(N.B.)—The Treasury appends the following explanatory notes for general information:—

1. The effects of the above Government Notice are that from the date thereof and until further notice all companies and persons, other than local authorities, may make issues of capital for any purpose whatsoever without application to or consent of the Treasury and that all conditions in respect of fixed property which the Treasury has hitherto imposed in any of its consents, under regulation 14, to any issue of capital, now fall away.

2. It is emphasised, however, that the prohibitions in regulation 13—see Proclamation No. 59 in Gazette No. 3775 of the 7th March, 1947—on the issue of bearer shares or bearer options and on the extension of the currency period of existing bearer options, are not affected by the aforementioned exemption and remain in full force.

3. Companies or persons in the Union or South West Africa who may desire to issue or raise capital in other countries are responsible for complying with any requirements which may there be in force. Any inquiries or applications which may be found necessary in such cases should be made, not to or through the Union Treasury, but to the authorities of the country concerned, either direct or through applicant's agent in such other country. In the case of capital to be issued or raised in the United Kingdom, applications are dealt with by the Capital Issues Committee of the British Treasury.

(Let Wel.)—Die Tesourie doen die volgende verklarende opmerkings vir algemene inligting:—

1. Die uitwerking van bogenoemde Goewernmentskennisgewing is dat vanaf die datum daardien en tot nadere kennisgewing, alle maatskappye en persone, behalwe plaaslike owerhede, uitgiftes van kapitaal mag doen vir watter doeleindes ook al sonder om aansoek by die Tesourie te doen of die toestemming van die Tesourie te verkry en dat alle voorwaardes ten opsigte van vaste eiendom wat die Tesourie tot nou toe in enige van sy toestemmings kragtens regulasie 14 tot enige uitgifte van kapitaal, opgelê het, nou vervat.

2. Dit word egter beklemtoon dat die verbod wat kragtens regulasie 13—sien Proklamasie No. 59 in Staatskoerant No. 3775 van 7 Maart 1947—op die uitreiking van toonderaandele of toonderopsies en op die verlenging van die looptyd van bestaande toonderopsies, opgelê is, nie deur voormelde vrystelling geraak word nie en in werking bly.

3. Maatskappye of persone in die Unie of Suidwes-Afrika wat kapitaal in ander lande wil uitreik of opneem, is verantwoordelik vir die voldoening aan alle vereistes wat daar in werking kan wees. Navrse of aansoek wat in sulke gevalle nodig kan wees, moet aan die owerheid van die betrokke land regstreeks of deur die applikant se verteenwoordiger in so'n land gerig word, en nie aan of deur bemiddeling van die Unie-tesourie nie. In gevalle waar kapitaal in die Verenigde Koninkryk uitreik of opgeneem word, behandel die komitee vir kapitaaluitgifte van die Britse tesourie die aansoek.
