BILL.

To amend the Workmen's Compensation Act, 1941.

(To be introduced by the MINISTER OF LABOUR.)

BE IT ENACTED by the Queen's Most Excellent Majesty. the Senate and the House of Assembly of the Union of South Africa, as follows:-

1. Section two of the Workmen's Compensation Act, 1941 Amendment of 5 (hereinafter referred to as the principal Act), is hereby amended—section 2 of Act 30 of 1941 as amended

(2) Any proclamation or notice issued under this Act prior to the date of commencement of the Workmen's Compensation Amendment Act, 1956, and in force after that date, the operation of which is not expressly limited to any area within the Union (excluding the territory) shall apply also in the territory with effect from the date of publication thereof in the territory.".

12. The laws of the territory of South-West Africa set out in Repeal of laws. the Schedule to this Act are hereby repealed to the extent set out in the third column of the Schedule with effect from the date

fixed by proclamation in terms of the proviso to section thirteen of this Act: Provided that any claim for compensation under 55 the said laws in respect of an accident which happened or a disease which was contracted prior to the date so fixed shall, save in so far as is otherwise provided in the principal Act as applied to the said territory by this Act, be dealt with thereunder as if this Act had not been passed.

13. This Act shall be called the Workmen's Compensation Short title and date Amendment Act, 1956, and shall come into operation on a date of commencement. to be fixed by the Governor-General by proclamation in the Gazette and the Official Gazette of the territory of South-West

Africa: Provided that the provisions of the Workmen's Com-65 pensation Act, 1941, relating to the right to compensation shall not come into operation in the said territory in terms of this Act until a date to be fixed in like manner.
