Kragtens die bevoegdheid my verleen by artikel 10(1) van die Wet op Nasionale Gedenkwaardighede, 1969 (Wet 28 van 1969), verklaar ek hierby Erf 374, tesame met die Rynse Sendingkerk daarop, te Keetmanshoop, Suidwes-Afrika, tot nasionale gedenkwaardigheid.

Under the powers vested in me by section 10(1) of the National Monuments Act, 1969 (Act 28 of 1969), I hereby declare Erf 374, together with the Rhenish Mission Church thereon, at Keetmanshoop, South West Africa, to be a national monument.

BESKRYWING

DESCRIPTION

Erf 374, met die historiese Rynse Sendingkerk daarop, geleë in die dorp Keetmanshoop en groot negentien (19) are, drie-en-negentig (93) vierkante meters, een-en-vyftig (51) vierkante desimeters, soos afgebeeld en beskryf in Diagram S.G.A. 48/30, geliasseer in die Landmeter-generaal se kantoor. Grond-brief 40/1932, gedateer 15.8.1932.

Erf 374, with the historic Rhenish Mission Church thereon, situate in the Township of Keetmanshoop, and Measuring nineteen (19) ares, ninety-three (93) square metres, fifty-one (51) square decimetres, as represented and described in diagram S.G. A.48/30, filed in the Surveyor-General's Office. Crown Grand 40/1932, dated 15.8.1932.

Nadat die Aub-rivier die vorige kerk in 1890 weggespoel het, is hierdie kerk onder toesig van eerw. T. Fenschel opgerig deur Nama-lidmate van die sendinggemeente. Die inwyding het plaasgevind op 8 Mei 1895.

After the previous church had been washed away in 1890 by the Aub river, this church was built under the supervision of the Rev. T. Fenschel by Nama members of the mission congregation. It was consecrated on 8 May 1895.
