REQUEST THAT A PORTION OF DISTRICT ROAD 1434 BE
DEVIATED, THAT THE CLASSIFICATION OF A PORTION
OF FARM ROAD 1437 BE CHANGED AND APPLICATION
THAT A PORTION OF FARM ROAD 1437 BE CLOSED:
DISTRICT OF WINDHOEK

It is hereby made known -

- (a) in terms of section 17(2) of the Roads Ordinance, 1972 (Ordinance 17 of 1972), that the Roads Board of Windhoek requests that -
- (i) the portion of district road 1434 described in paragraph (a) of Schedule I and shown on sketch-map P1466 by the symbols A-B, be deviated from the route so described and shown, to the route described in paragraph (b) of the said Schedule and shown on sketch-map P1466 by the symbols A-C; and
 - (ii) the classification of the portion of farm road 1437 described in Schedule II and shown on sketch-map P1466 by the symbols B-C, be changed to district road (number 1434); and
- (b) in terms of section 16(3) of the said Ordinance, that application has been made to the Chairman of the Roads Board of Windhoek, that the portion of farm road 1437 described in Schedule III and shown on sketch-map P1466 by the symbols D-E, be closed.

A copy of this notice and the said sketch-map, being a sketch-map of the area concerned on which the road to which the request and application refer and other proclaimed, minor and private roads in that area are shown, shall for the full period of thirty days mentioned below lie open to inspection at the offices of the Permanent Secretary for Works, Transport and Communication, Windhoek, and the Roads Superintendent, Windhoek, during normal office hours.

Every person having any objection to the above-mentioned request or application, or both the request and application, is hereby commanded to lodge his or her objection in writing, with the grounds upon which it is based clearly and specifically therein stated, with the Chairman of Roads Boards, Private Bag 12005, Ausspannplatz, 9000, within a period of thirty days from the date of publication of this notice.

SCHEDULE I

- (a) From a point (A on sketch-map P1466) on district road 1434 on the farm Otjikundua 155 generally north-north-westwards across the said farm and the farm Hummelshain 154 to a point (B on sketch-map P1466) on the said district road at the junction with farm road 1437 on the last-mentioned farm.
- (b) From a point (A on sketch-map P1466) on district road 1434 on the farm Otjikundua 155 generally northwards and more and more north-north-westwards across the said farm and the farm Hummelshain 154 to a point (C on sketch-map P1466) on farm road 1437 on the last-mentioned farm.

SCHEDULE II

From a point (B on sketch-map P1466) on district road 1434 on the farm Hummelshain 154 generally eastwards across the said farm to a point (C on sketch-map P1466) on the said farm.

SCHEDULE III

From a point (D on sketch-map P1466) on the bank of the Black Nossob River which is also the common boundary of the farms Otjisauna Nord 157 and Otjisauna Süd 156 generally eastwards and more and more east-north-eastwards across the last-mentioned farm to a point (E on sketch-map P1466) on the bank of the said river which is also the common boundary of the last-mentioned farm and the farm Otjisauna Nord 157.
