#### DETERMINATION OF MAXIMUM ANNUAL FINANCE CHARGE RATES: USURY ACT, 1968

Under section 2(1), (2) and (3) of the Usury Act, 1968 (Act 73 of 1968), I hereby determine, in accordance with the directions of the Minister of Finance, that no money lender shall in connection with any money lending transaction, and no credit grantor shall in connection with any credit transaction, and no lessor shall in connection with any leasing transaction, stipulate for, demand or receive finance charges at an annual finance charge rate greater than the appropriate percentage mentioned in the Schedule.

Government Notice 27 of 1994 is hereby repealed.


