**DETERMINATION OF RATE FOR PURPOSES OF EXEMPTION
UNDER SECTION 16(1)(m)(iii) OF THE INCOME TAX ACT, 1981**

Under paragraph (aa) of the proviso to section 16(1)(m)(iii) of the Income Tax Act, 1981 (Act 24 of 1981), I hereby determine that the rate at which dividends on Special Tax-Free Indefinite Period Shares are to be calculated for purposes of the exemption contemplated in that section, shall be -

- (a) 15 per cent for shares issued during the period 1 April 1997 to 31 March 1998, and
- (b) 13 per cent for shares issued after 31 March 1998.

**DEVIATION OF A PORTION OF FARM ROAD 1625:
DISTRICT OF GOBABIS: OMAHEKE REGION**

In terms of section 22(2) of the Roads Ordinance, 1972 (Ordinance 17 of 1972), it is hereby made known that the Minister has under section 22(1)(c) of the said Ordinance, in the district of Gobabis, deviated the portion of farm road 1625 described in paragraph (a) of the Schedule and shown on sketch-map P1561 by the symbols A-B-C-D, from the route so described and shown, to the route described in paragraph (b) of the Schedule and shown on sketch-map P1561 by the symbols D-E-F-G.
