REGULATIONS, 1963

## SCHEDULE

1. 2. The following Paragraph is hereby substituted for Paragraph E. 3 of Annex E of the Regulations:
"Paragraph E. 3

## E. 3 PASSENGER SERVICE CHARGES

The following passenger service charges are payable by an aircraft operator engaged in commercial air transport operations. Payment is to be made within 30 days of having received an invoice in such regard:

(Passenger service charges are not applicable to passengers in transit for less than 6 hours, passengers who have not yet reached their second birthday and flight and cabin crew members travelling in the course of duty)."

## CLOSING OF FARM ROAD 603: DISTRICT OF KEETMANSHOOP: KARAS REGION

In terms of section 22(2) of the Roads Ordinance, 1972 (Ordinance 17 of 1972), it is hereby made known that the Minister has under section 22(1)(c) of the said Ordinance, in the district of Keetmanshoop, closed farm road 603 described in the Schedule and shown on sketch-map P2025 by the symbols A-B-C.

The said sketch-map shall at all times lie open to inspection at the office of the Permanent Secretary: Works, Transport and Communication, Windhoek, during normal office hours.

## SCHEDULE

From a point (A on sketch-map P2025) at the junction with main road 28 on the farm Oase 195 generally north-eastwards and more and more north-north-eastwards across the said farm, the Railway line and the farms Portion 1 (Sandhoek) of Gabasis West 112 and the Remainder of Gababis West 112 to a point (B on sketch-map P2025) on the common boundary of the last-mentioned farm and the farm Naute 119; thence generally north-north-eastwards and more and more north-eastwards across the lastmentioned farm and the farm Nanebis 120 to a point (C on sketch-map P2025) at the junction with farm road 604 on the last-mentioned farm.
