AIRPORTS COMPANY ACT, 1998: CHARGES FOR COMPANY AIRPORTS AND AERODROMES

Under section 14(12) of the Airports Company Act, 1998 (Act No. 25 of 1998), I hereby publish the aerodrome charges for aerodromes and airports transferred to the Company. These charges will take effect on 5 November 1998 and shall be paid to the Chief Executive Officer, Namibian Airports Company.
