DISPOSAL OF UNDESIRABLE MEDICINES
MEDICINES AND RELATED SUBSTANCES CONTROL ACT, 1965

The Medicines Control Council has in terms of section 23(1) of the Medicines and Related Substances Control Act, 1965 (Act No. 101 of 1965) resolved that it is not in the public interest that any medicine containing **chlormezanone** be made available to the public.

Any person in possession of medicine containing any quantity of **chlormezanone** is directed to return such medicine to the manufacturer thereof or, in the case of imported medicine, to the importer concerned.

Any person aggrieved by the decision of the Medicines Control Council may in terms of section 24(1) of the said Act appeal against such decision.

In terms of section 29 of the Act it is an offence if any person fails to comply with the

direction of the Medicines Control Council or, in contravention of section 23(3), sells any such medicine.

For cafés, tea rooms, restaurants, boarding houses, private hotels, commercial banks, shops, shop windows, advertising signs, offices, licenced hotels, theatres, bioscopes, residential clubs, Government offices, post offices, convents, schools, school hostels, railway recreation clubs, workshops, garages, factories, butchers, bakeries and every building plot which can be connected to the Council's reticulation and such other premises as the Council may with the approval of the Executive Committee determine and where electricity current is used mainly for other purposes than bona fide household purposes:-

- (i) Each consumer connected to the Council's distribution system and to whom supply has not been stopped - a monthly levy (Basic Charges) of N\$97.20 plus N\$0.38 per unit

Tariff C: Bulk Consumer:-

For all consumers using 10 000 or more units per month:-

- (i) Low Tension:-
Per month N\$3.00 per kVA with a monthly minimum amount of N\$300.00 plus N\$0.38 for each unit consumed per month.
- (ii) High Tension:-
per month N\$3.00 per kVA with a monthly minimum amount of N\$300.00 plus N\$0.38 for each unit consumed per month.

Tariff D: Special Tariff:-

For the Department of Water Affairs and such other premises as the Council may with the approval of the Executive Committee determine and where electric current is used mainly for purposes other than under Tariffs A, B and C:-

N\$3.00 per kVA plus N\$0.38 per unit consumed per month

Tariff E: Departmental Consumption:-

N\$0.38 per unit consumed per month.

Tariff F: Sporting Bodies and Clubs not in possession of Liquor Licences:-

N\$0.38 per unit consumed per month.

Tariff G: Pre-Paid Meters:-

N\$0.46 per unit, per meter card.
