EXTENSION OF PERIOD FOR WHICH REGISTERED COLLECTIVE AGREEMENT RELATING TO THE CONSTRUCTION INDUSTRY SHALL BE BINDING ON EMPLOYEES AND EMPLOYERS IN THAT INDUSTRY: LABOUR ACT, 1992

Under section 70(4) of the Labour Act, 1992 (Act No. 6 of 1992), and on the request of the Construction Industries Federation of Namibia (CIF) and the Metal and Allied Namibian Workers' Union (MANWU), I hereby extend the period ending 31 March 2000, fixed in Government Notice No. 135 of 16 July 1999, for which the registered collective agreement set fourth in the Schedule to that Government Notice was declared to be binding on the parties, employers and employees mentioned in that Government Notice, for an indefinite period until that agreement is replaced by a further collective agreement.
