**NATIONAL VOCATIONAL TRAINING ACT, 1944:
 NOTIFICATION OF INTENTION TO APPROVE TRAINING SCHEME**

Under section 15(2)(a) of the National Vocational Training Act, 1994 (Act No. 18 of 1994), I hereby give notice of my intention to approve the training scheme established by the Vocational Training Board under section 14(2) of that Act in respect of the designated trade set out below, and which shall apply as conditions of apprenticeship in that trade.

The above-mentioned scheme, or copies thereof, shall for a period of 30 days after the date of publication of this notice, be open for inspection by the public during normal office hours at the Offices of the Permanent Secretary: Higher Education, Training and Employment Creation, Windhoek, and of the Chief Trade Testing Officer, National Trade Testing and Certification Centre, Khomasdal, and of the Human Resource Manager, Human Resource Development Centre, NamWater, Okahandja.

Every person having any objection to that scheme is hereby invited to lodge, within the aforesaid period of 30 days, his or her objection in writing with the chairperson of the Vocational Training Board, Private Bag 13391, Windhoek, stating the specific grounds of objection and the deletions from, or additions or modifications to, that scheme which the objector may propose.
