CONSERVANCY SITUATED IN THE ERONGO REGION**

The point of beginning is at point 1, which is situated at the intersection of the National West Coast Recreational Area and the Ugab River at the co-ordinates set out below.

From the point of beginning in an easterly direction following the middle-line of the Ugab River until point 2; from point 2 it turns in a south-easterly direction through point 3 to point 4; from point 4 in an easterly direction to point 5, thence south-easterly direction through point 6 to point 7; from this point in an easterly direction to point 8, whence it turns in a southerly direction through points 9 and 10 to point 11 in the middle-line of the Omaruru River; from this point it follows the middle-line of the river until it intersects the National West Coast Recreational Area at point 12; from this point it follows the boundary of the National West Coast Recreational Area in a north-westerly direction to the point of the beginning.

SITUATED IN THE KUNENE REGION**

The point of beginning is at point 1 which is at a survey beacon situated on the western border of the Etosha National Park.

From the point of beginning in a westerly direction to point 2, thence southwards through points 3 and 4 to point 5; from this point in a south-easterly direction through point 6 to point 7, whence it turns to the south-westerly direction to point 8; from this point in a southerly direction through points 9, 10, 11, 12 and 13 to point 14, thence south-westerly direction through point 15 to point 16; from this point in a south-easterly direction through points 17 and 18 to point 19 which is situated on the veterinary fence near Palmfontein; from this point it follows the veterinary fence in a northerly direction until it intersects the Western Etosha National Park boundary fence at Werda veterinary gate, thence follows the Etosha National Park boundary fence in a northerly direction until the point of beginning.

From the point of beginning in a southerly direction following the boundary of the Skeleton Coast Park until point 2, whence it turns in an easterly direction to point 3 at a junction on the main road to the Kunene River, thence north-easterly direction through point 4 to point 5; from this point in a north-westerly direction through points 6, 7 and 8 to point 9, intersects the Kunene River boundary of Namibia and Angola; from point 9 in a westerly direction following the Kunene River boundary of Namibia and Angola until the point of beginning.
