**DESCRIPTION OF BOUNDARY OF THE !KHOB !NAUB (KALK PLATEAU)
 CONSERVANCY SITUATED IN THE KARAS REGION**

The point of beginning is at the co-ordinates of point 1. From this point the boundary moves in a south-eastern direction through point 2, 3 and 4 before moving south-westerly to point 5. From point 5 the boundary moves southwards through point 6, 7, 8 and 9. From point 9 the boundary follows the northern boundaries of the farms Blau-Ost 143 and Blaukehl-Nord 141 and then moves southwards along the eastern boundaries of the farms Blaukehl-Nord 41 and Blaukehl-SUD 142. The boundary then moves in a north-western direction along the southern boundary of the farm Blaukehl-Sud 142 before turning southwards along the eastern boundary of the farm Bloemhof 311 and then north-westerly along the southern boundary of Bloemhof 311. From this last point the boundary moves southwards along the eastern boundary of the farm Itzawisis 9 and then in a south-western direction along the southern boundary of the farm Itzawisis 9 until it meets the railway line. The boundary then follows the railway line in a northern direction until it meets the southern boundary of the farm Dickdorn 13. From this point the boundary follows the southern boundary of Dickdorn 13 westwards for a short distance before turning northwards along the western boundary of Dickdorn 13 and then eastwards along the northern boundaries of farms Dickdorn 13 and Mukorob 14. From this point the boundary runs southwards along the eastern boundary of Mukorob 14 and then in a south-eastern direction along the common boundaries separating state land and the farms Daberas Pforte 15 and Zaries 20 and then to the point of beginning.

The Townlands of Tses are excluded.

The point of beginning is at point 1, which is situated in the south-eastern corner of the conservancy. From the point of beginning the boundary follows the veterinary fence in a western direction up to point 2, when it turns north-westerly along the veterinary fence to point 3 and then in a northern direction still following the veterinary fence to point 4. From this point the boundary turns eastwards to point 5 and then in a south-western direction up to point 6, whereupon it follows a road in a north-eastern direction to point 7. From here the boundary moves in a south-western direction to point 8 before turning southwards to point 9, which is situated on the main Tsumkwe-Grootfontein road. The boundary follows this road in a western direction through point 10 to point 11, before turning southwards to point 12 and then in a south-western direction to point 13. From this point the boundary follows a road in a southern direction up to the point of beginning.

**DESCRIPTION OF BOUNDARY OF THE //HUAB CONSERVANCY
SITUATED IN THE KUNENE REGION**

The point of beginning is the most eastern corner of farm **Halt 379** at point **A**.

From the point of beginning the boundary follows the south-eastern boundary of **Halt 379** in a south-western direction; and then moves in a generally western direction along the southern boundaries, in turn, of farms **Halt 379**, **Horison 489**, **Tussenby 729**, **Bergville 490**, **Lofdal 491**, **Ruimte 510**, **Rushof 509**, and **Toekoms 508** to point **B** at the most southern corner of **Toekoms 508**. From point **B** the boundary continues in a generally north-western direction along the western boundaries, in turn, of farms **Toekoms 508**, **Boesmanspan 507**, **Soutput 505** and **Noute 674** to point **C** at the north-western corner of **Noute 674**. From point **C** the boundary proceeds in a generally eastern and then north-eastern direction along the northern boundaries, in turn, of farms **Noute 674**, **Eersbegin 675**, **Tweelingskops 676**, and **Anabis 677** to point **D** at the north-eastern corner of **Anabis 677**. From point **D** the boundary carries on firstly in a southern direction along the eastern borders of farms **Anabis 677** and **Spitskop 678** to the intersection with the north-western corner of farm **Aub 683**, and then in an eastern direction along the northern borders of farms **Aub 683** and **Smalruggens 684** to point **E** at the north-eastern corner of **Smalruggens 684**. From point **E** the boundary progresses in a south-eastern and then south-western direction along, firstly, the eastern boundary of **Smalruggens 684** and then the southern boundaries of farms **Smalruggens 684** and **Rockeyes 682** to point **F** where it meets the north-eastern corner of farm **Braklaagte 492**. From point **F** the boundary advances in a south-eastern direction along the eastern boundary of **Braklaagte 492**, continues along the north-eastern boundary of farm **Potgietersrust 489**, turns easterly and then continues along the northern boundary of **Horison 489** to its intersection with the most northern corner of **Halt 379**, and then returns in a south-eastern direction along the north-eastern boundary of **Halt 379** back to the point of beginning.
