### AMENDMENT OF THE NATIONAL CELLULAR TELECOMMUNICATIONS LICENCES ISSUED TO MTC AND CELL ONE UNDER THE NAMIBIAN COMMUNICATIONS COMMISSION ACT, 1992 (ACT NO. 4 OF 1992), THE NAMIBIAN COMMUNICATIONS COMMISSION AMENDMENT ACT 1995, (ACT NO. 1 OF 1995) AND THE NAMIBIAN COMMUNICATIONS COMMISSION AMENDMENT ACT, 2004 (ACT NO. 4 OF 2004)

It is hereby made known for general information that the Namibian Communications Commission has in terms of section 22A of the Namibian Communications Commission Amendment Act, 1995 (Act No. 1 of 1995) amended Section 20.1.C of both MTC and Cell One licences that requires cost based termination rates for interconnections between operators as follows:

Telecom Namibia Ltd, MTC and Cell One agreed on the following compromise termination rate model:

- The termination rate ceiling as from 1st July 2009 for mobile to mobile, mobile to fixed and fixed to mobile calls will be N\$ 0.60 per minute, charged in per second intervals
- Operator terminating international calls for an operator with an international voice licence will receive N\$ 0.60 per minute, charged in per seconds intervals, for the termination of calls
- Operator with a international voice gateway will be restricted to the transit charge of N\$ 0.60 per minute, charged in per seconds intervals, plus the international settlement fee payable to the foreign operator for terminating that call. The international settlement fees will be calculated each month based on the average for the last month for each destination.

The termination ceiling will be reduced further every six months until the estimated cost of an efficient operator of N\$ 0.30 per minute, charged in per second intervals has been reached.
