## SCHEDULE

### Definitions

1. In this Schedule, “unless the context otherwise indicates, a word or expression defined in the Act has the same meaning and-

“practitioner” means a person registered under the Act to practise any allied or complementary health profession specified in section 18 of the Act; or any other profession declared under section 60 of the Act as an allied or complementary health profession to which the Act applies, but excluding a supplementary practitioner;

“student” means a person studying or receiving education, tuition or training at an educational institution for the purpose of obtaining a qualification which will enable the person to be registered as a practitioner or as a supplementary practitioner;

“supplementary practitioner” means a practitioner who, in terms of his or her scope of practice as prescribed under section 55 of the Act –

- (a) may not conduct a private practice; and
- (b) must practise his or her profession in the employ or under the supervision of a practitioner or of any other person authorised by the Council;

“the Act” means the Allied Health Professions Act, 2004 (Act No. 7 of 2004).
