Additional Appropriation (1995/1996) Act 28 of 1995

(GG 1233)

came into force on date of publication: 30 December 1995

ACT

To appropriate additional amounts of money to meet the financial requirements of the State during the financial year ending 31 March 1996.

(Signed by the President on 22 December 1995)

BE IT ENACTED by the Parliament of the Republic of Namibia, as follows:-

Appropriation of amounts of money for financial requirements of State

1. Subject to the provisions of the State Finance Act, 1991 (Act 31 of 1991), there are hereby appropriated for the financial requirements of the State during the financial year ending 31 March 1996, as a charge to the State Revenue Fund, the additional amounts of money shown in the Schedule.

Short title

2. This Act shall be called the Additional Appropriation (1995/1996) Act, 1995.
