

Republic of Namibia Annotated Statutes

Appropriation Act 2 of 2002

(GG 2767) came into force on date of publication: 18 July 2002

ACT

To appropriate amounts of money to meet the financial requirements of the State during the financial year ending 31 March 2003.

(Signed by the President on 3 July 2002)

BE IT ENACTED by the Parliament of the Republic of Namibia, as follows:-

Appropriation of amounts of money for the financial requirements of the State

1. Subject to the provisions of the State Finance Act, 1991 (Act No. 31 of 1991), there are appropriated for the financial requirements of the State during the financial year ending 31 March 2003, as a charge to the State Revenue Fund, the amounts of money shown in the Schedule.

Short title

2. This Act is called the Appropriation Act, 2002.
