## **Powers of the SWA Water and Electricity Corporation Act 14 of 1980.**

**Summary:** This Act gives certain powers to the SWA Water and Electricity Corporation (Pty) Ltd, subject to the approval of the Minister of Mines and Energy. (This corporation is now known as “NamPower”.)

**Application of Act:** Namibia Power Corporation (Pty) Ltd is deemed to be a company registered in terms of Chapter IV of the *Companies Act 61 of 1973* by Proc.7/1998 (GG 1849),

## **Electricity Act 2 of 2000.**

**Summary:** This Act provides for the establishment and functions of the Electricity Control Board. It replaces the Electric Power Proclamation 4 of 1922. The Act came into force on 12 July 2000 (GN 167/2000, GG 2371).

**Regulations:** Electricity Regulations (Administrative) are contained in GN 168/2000 (GG 2371).

GN 144/2001 (GN 2579) concerns the application of section 41 of the Act. Levies in terms of section 13 are addressed in GN 145/2001 (GG 2579).
