

Terms and Conditions – Comic Competition

1. Introduction
 - a. The Terms and Conditions below only apply to the “Comic Competition” held by the Legal Assistance Centre (LAC) running from 01 August 2022 to 30 September 2022.
 - b. To enter the competition you must enter as directed on the LAC’s website at www.lac.org.na and flyer.
2. Eligibility and entry restrictions
 - a. Only students/scholars of NEEN schools and Namibian UNESCO ASPnet schools are eligible to enter.
 - b. Each student/scholar is eligible to enter once. No student/scholar is allowed to enter through more than one project or group.
 - c. Entrants must not be LAC employees, immediate relatives of LAC employees or persons involved in the organising of the competition.
 - d. Teachers do not enter the competition but are strongly encouraged to assist with submitting the applications.
3. Start and closing dates
 - a. The competition opens on 01 August 2022 and closes for entries on 30 September 2022 (COB).
 - b. Any entries received before the opening or after the closing of the competition will be invalid and will not be entered into the competition. No exceptions will be made.
 - c. No responsibility can be accepted for entries not received by the Promoter, for whatever reason.
 - d. The Promoter reserve the right to cancel or amend the terms and conditions of the competition without prior notice, and only in the event of vis major or any actual or anticipated breach of any applicable law or regulation or any event outside of the Promoter’s control
 - e. Any changes to the competition will be notified to entrants as soon as possible by the Promoter.
4. Winners and prizes
 - a. Competition prizes are specified on the LAC’s website at www.lac.org.na
 - b. The winners will be announced at the National Awards Show for the [World’s Largest Lesson](#) that will take place in November 2022. [More details will be communicated closer to the event.](#)
 - c. Announcing the Winners will include publicising the name of the school, the name of the group or the individual and the details of the prizes won.
 - d. Prizes may not be transferred to cash or otherwise.
5. Publicity
 - a. The Promoter reserves its right to make public all the information of the winners which may include the name of the school, the name of the group or the name of the individual, photographs taken at the event and any other information relevant for the purpose of marketing.
6. Copyright and moral rights
 - a. Entrants warrant that the comics entered for the competition is their own work and that the use of these entries, in accordance with these rules, will not infringe any person’s intellectual property rights or any other legal right.
 - b. Entrants grant the LAC complete ownership of their entries and the exclusive, royalty-free, worldwide, perpetual, and irrevocable license to copy, store, edit, print, distribute and publish such entries.
 - c. To the maximum extent permitted by applicable law, you irrevocably and unconditionally waive your rights to be identified as the author of your comic submitted for purposes of the competition.
 - d. Entrants agree that any dispute that may arise relating to this competition shall be settled by mediation proceedings.
 - e. The Promoter reserves the right to annul any entry in the event that a breach of these rules occur.
 - f. By entering this competition an entrant is indicating his / her agreement to be bound by all these terms and conditions
