UNDER and by virtue of the powers in me vested by paragraph (h) of section two of the Magistrates' Courts Act 1917 of the Union Parliament as applied to the Territory of South-West Africa by the Administration of Justice Proclamation, 1919, I do hereby proclaim, declare and make known that paragraph two of the Schedule to Proclamation of the Administrator of the Protectorate of South-West Africa No. 33 of 1920, shall be and is hereby amended by the insertion of the words "Bitterwasser . . . . . No. 116" between the words "Hoachanas . . . . . No. 120" and "Farm B. . . . . No. 115" where they occur in the said paragraph.
