NADEMAAL dit wenslik is om 'werking van die wet
wat voorsiening maak vir 'n minimumloon vir naturelle in
die Gebied op te kort;

SO IS DIT dat ek, kragtens die bevoegdheid my verleen,
hiermee proklameer, verklaar en bekend maak soos volg:—

1. Artikel *dertien* van die Proklamasie betreffende
Minimumlone vir Naturelle, 1944 (No. 1 van 1944), word hier-
mee gewysig deur die skraping van die woorde „1 Januarie
1944” en die vervanging daarvan deur die woorde „'n datum
deur Administrateur by proklamasie in die *Offisiele Koerant*
bepaal te word”.

2. Hierdie Proklamasie heet die Wysigingsproklamasie
betreffende Minimumlone vir Naturelle, 1944, en word geag
in werking getree te hê op 1 Januarie 1944.

PROCLAMATION

BY HIS HONOUR PETRUS IMKER HOOGENHOUT,
ADMINISTRATOR OF SOUTH WEST AFRICA.

No. 5 of 1944.]

WHEREAS it is expedient to suspend the operation of
the law providing for a minimum wage for natives in the
Territory;

NOW THEREFORE, under and by virtue of the powers
in me vested, I do hereby proclaim, declare and make known
as follows:—

1. Section *thirteen* of the Natives Minimum Wage Pro-
clamation, 1944 (No. 1 of 1944), is hereby amended by the
deletion of the words “the first day of January, 1944” and
the substitution therefor of the words “a date to be fixed
by the Administrator by proclamation in the *Gazette*”.

2. This Proclamation shall be called the Natives Minimum
Wage Amendment Proclamation, 1944, and shall be deemed to
have taken effect on the first day of January, 1944.
