FOOT AND MOUTH DISEASE REGULATIONS.

The Administrator has been pleased under and by virtue of the powers in him vested by sections 16 and 23 of the Diseases of Stock Proclamation, 1920 (Proclamation No. 28 of 1920) as amended from time to time to make the following regulations:—

(1) No cattle, sheep, goats, or pigs shall be moved out of or into or from any one place to any other place in the area defined hereunder, except on the authority of a written permit issued by the Director of Agriculture or the local Government Veterinary Officer and subject to such conditions as may be specified in such permit:—

The Epukiro Native Reserve No. 329, the Aminuis Native Reserve No. 330, and that portion of the Gobabis Magisterial District bounded by and including the following farms:—

Nos. 420, 437, 443, 448, 455, Etna No. 405, Hertzog No. 469, Winnecke No. 470, Elandsberg No. 290, Valérie No. 291, Kamichab No. 347, Suyas No. 357, Goab No. 363, Elsdale No. 372, Nuiba No. 373, Goreb No. 374, Nos. 375, 376, 377, 368, Natus No. 359, Gensbokfontein No. 354, Nos. 352, 477, Sandfontein No. 468, Nos. 522, 521, 447, 439, 438, 434, 433, 432, 431, 430 and 429.

(2) No hides, skins, hair, horns, meat, bones, or wool shall be moved out of the area described in Regulation 1, except on the authority of a written permit issued by the Director of Agriculture or the local Government Veterinary Officer and subject to such conditions as may be specified in such permit.
