En nademaan die Goewerneur-generaal, ingevolge die bepaling van paraagraaf (b) van artikel *nege-en-twintig* van gesagte Wet, indien hy dit in die openbare belang ag, enigiemand van verbind om beperkte materiaal uit te voer, behalwe op gesag van 'n permit uitgereik deur die voorste van die adjunk-voorsitter van die Raad op Atoomkrag;

En nademan ek dit in die openbare belang ag dat ek die voorste van beril en ander erts van beryllium uit die Unie of die Mandaatgebied Suidwes-Afrika aldus verbied;

So is dit dat ek, kragtens die bevoegheid my verleen by paraagraaf (b) van artikel *nege-en-twintig* van die Wet op Atoomkrag, 1948 (Wet No. 35 van 1948), hierby enigiemand verbied om van 'n datum voorste dae na die publikasie van sydiese proklamasie in die *Staatskoerant*, beril of ander erts uit te voer, behalwe op gesag van 'n permit uitgereik deur die voorste of die adjunk-voorsitter van die Raad op Atoomkrag.

PROCLAMATION

BY HIS EXCELLENCY THE RIGHT HONOURABLE GIDEON BRAND VAN ZYL, A MEMBER OF HIS MAJESTY'S MOST HONOURABLE PRIVY COUNCIL, DOCTOR OF LAWS, GOVERNOR-GENERAL OF THE UNION OF SOUTH AFRICA.

No. 19, 1950 (Union).]

Whereas beryl and any other ores of beryllium are restricted material for the purpose of the Atomic Energy Act, 1948 (Act No. 35 of 1948);

And whereas in terms of the provisions of paragraph (b) of section twenty-nine of the said Act the Governor-General may, if he considers it in the public interest, prohibit any person from exporting any restricted material except under the authority of a permit issued by the chairman or the deputy-chairman of the Atomic Energy Board;

And whereas I consider it in the public interests so to prohibit the export of beryl and any other ores of beryllium from the Union or the Mandated Territory of South West Africa;

Now, therefore, under and by virtue of the powers vested in me by the said paragraph (b) of section twenty-nine of the Atomic Energy Act, 1948 (Act No. 35 of 1948), I do hereby prohibit, as from a date fourteen days after the publication of this proclamation in the *Government Gazette*, any person from exporting any beryl or any other ores of beryllium from the Union or the Mandated Territory of South West Africa except under the authority of a permit issued by the chairman or the deputy-chairman of the Atomic Energy Board.

Die aandag word gevestig op Proklamasie No. 19, gepubliseer in die *Staatskantoor* van 10 Februarie 1950, waarby die uitvoer van beryll of ander erts van beryllium uit die Unie en Suidwes-Afrika verbied word, uitgesondert kragtens 'n permit uitgereik deur die voorsitter of die adjunk-voorsitter van die Raad op Atoomkrag.

Iedereen wat begerig is om sodanige permit te bekou, moet daarom aansoek doen by die Waarnemende Sekretaris, Raad op Atoomkrag, p/a Die Sekretaris van Mynwese, Standardbankgebou, Pretoria, en moet die volgende besonderde verstrek:—

1. Naam en adres van voornemende uitvoerder.
2. Naam en adres van produsent of produsente.
3. Naam en nommer van plaas of klein, prospakteergebieid of in mineralverhuring on die distrik waar die erts geproduseer is.
4. Berilliumoksiedgehalte van die erts, indien beskikbaar.
5. Die hoeveelheid erts wat uitgevoer sal word en die tydperk waarin hierdie hoeveelheid uitgevoer sal word.
6. Hawe van verskeping en die land van bestemming.
7. Die naam en adres van die invoerder in daardie land.

Attention is invited to Proclamation No. 19, published in the *Government Gazette* of the 10th February, 1950, whereby the export of beryl or other ores of beryllium from the Union and South West Africa is prohibited except under the authority of a permit issued by the chairman or the deputy-chairman of the Atomic Energy Board.

Any person who desires to obtain such a permit shall apply therefor to the Acting Secretary, Atomic Energy Board, c/o The Secretary for Mines, Standard Bank Buildings, Pretoria, and must furnish the following particulars:—

1. The name and address of the intending exporter.
2. The name and address of the producer or producers.
3. The name and number of the farm or claim, prospecting area or mineral lease, and the district from which the ore was produced.
4. Beryllium oxide content of the ore, if available.
5. The quantity of ore to be exported, and the period during which this quantity will be exported.
6. Port of shipment and country of destination.
7. The name and address of the importer in that country.
