APPLICATION OF AMENDMENTS TO THE SOUTH AFRICA DEFENCE ACT, 1912 (ACT NO. 13 OF 1912) AND THE REGULATIONS MADE THEREUNDER TO SOUTH WEST AFRICA AND THE PORT AND SETTLEMENT OF WALVIS BAY.

WHEREAS by Proclamation 234 of 1939 the South Africa Defence Act, 1912 (Act No. 13 of 1912), as amended, and the regulations made thereunder were put in operation in South West Africa and the port and settlement of Walvis Bay;

AND WHEREAS the said South Africa Defence Act, 1912, has been further amended by—

Section 1 of the Pension Laws Amendment Act, 1943 (Act No. 33 of 1943);

Section 46 of the War Pensions Laws Amendment Act, 1946 (Act No. 58 of 1946);

The Defence Amendment Act, 1947 (Act No. 39 of 1947); and

The Defence Amendment Act, 1949 (Act No. 43 of 1949);

AND WHEREAS it is expedient that the further amendments shall also be put in operation in South West Africa, and the said port and settlement;

NOW THEREFORE, under the powers vested in me by section two of the Walvis Bay and St. John's River Territories Annexation Act, 1884 (Act No. 35 of 1884), of the Cape of Good Hope, section two of the Treaty of Peace and South West Africa Mandate Act, 1919 (Act No. 19 of 1919), and section one of the South West Africa Affairs Act, 1922 (Act No. 24 of 1922), I hereby declare—

Section 1 of the Pension Laws Amendment Act, 1943 (Act No. 33 of 1943);

Section 46 of the War Pensions Laws Amendment Act, 1946 (Act No. 58 of 1946);

The Defence Amendment Act, 1947 (Act No. 39 of 1947); and

The Defence Amendment Act, 1949 (Act No. 43 of 1949), and the regulations made thereunder to be in force in and to apply to South West Africa and the port and settlement of Walvis Bay.
