ALGEMENE VERKIESING VAN SENATORE IN SUIDWES-AFRIKA.

NADEMAAL by artikel dertig van die Wysigingswet op Aangeleenthede van Suidwes-Afrika, 1949, bepaal word dat die gebied Suidwes-Afrika deur twee benoemde en twee gekose Senatore in die Senaat verteenwoordig moet word;

EN NADEMAAL dit dienstig is om tot die verkiezing van die laasgenoemde twee Senatore oor te gaan;

SO IS DIT dat ek, kragtens die bevoegdheid my verleen by artikel dertig van die Wysigingswet op Aangeleenthede van Suidwes-Afrika, 1949, en subparagraaf (2) van paragraaf 2 en subparagraaf (1) van paragraaf 5 van die regulasies betreffende die gesamentlike verkiezing van Senatore in Suidwes-Afrika, afgeleidend by Goewernementskenningsgewing No. 1574 van 14 Julie 1950, hierby as volg verklaar—

- (1) dat Donderdag die ag-en-twintigste dag van September 1950 vasgestel is as die dag waarop 'n sitting van al die lede van die Volksraad en van die Wetgewende Vergadering volgens die bedoeling van subparagraaf (1) van paragraaf 1 van voormelde regulasies, gehou moet word;
- (2) dat voormelde sitting gehou moet word om 10.30 in die voormiddag van voormelde dag;
- (3) dat die sitting in die Vergaderingsaal van die Wetgewende Vergadering, Windhoek, gehou moet word;
- (4) dat Mnr. Dirk Jacobus Greyling, Klerk-assistent van die Wetgewende Vergadering, Suidwes-Afrika, hierby benoem word tot Assistent-kiesbeaamp te die verkiezing.

PROCLAMATION

BY HIS EXCELLENCY THE RIGHT HONOURABLE ERNEST FREDERICK WATERMEYER, A MEMBER OF HIS MAJESTY'S MOST HONOURABLE PRIVY COUNCIL, OFFICER ADMINISTERING THE GOVERNMENT OF THE UNION OF SOUTH AFRICA.

No. 220 of 1950 (Union).]

GENERAL ELECTION OF SENATORS IN SOUTH-WEST AFRICA.

WHEREAS by section thirty of the South-West Africa Affairs Amendment Act, 1949, it is provided that the territory of South-West Africa shall be represented in the Senate by two nominated and two elected Senators;

AND WHEREAS it is expedient to proceed to the election of the last mentioned two Senators;

NOW, THEREFORE, under and by virtue of the powers and authority vested in me by section thirty of the South-West Africa Affairs Amendment Act, 1949, and sub-paragraph (2) of paragraph 2 and sub-paragraph (1) of paragraph 5 of the regulations in regard to the joint election of Senators in South-West Africa, published under Government Notice No. 1574 of the 14th July, 1950, I do hereby declare—

- (1) that Thursday, the twenty-eighth day of September, 1950 shall be the day on which a sitting of all members of the House of Assembly and of the Legislative Assembly within the meaning of paragraph 1 (1) of the aforesaid regulations, shall be held;
- (2) that the aforesaid sitting shall be held at 10.30 in the forenoon of the aforesaid day;
- (3) that the sitting shall be held in the Chamber of the Legislative Assembly, Windhoek;
- (4) that Mr. Dirk Jacobus Greyling, Clerk Assistant of the Legislative Assembly, South-West Africa, shall be and is hereby appointed to be the Assistant Returning Officer at the election.

SO IS DIT dat ek, kragtens die bevoegdheid my verleen, die Wetgewende Vergadering by hierdie Proklamasie oproep om op die sewe-en-twintigste dag van September 1950, byeen te kom en verklaar ek hierby dat die Eerste Sessie van die Eerste Sessie van die Sesde Wetgewende Vergadering gehou sal word te Windhoek om elf uur in die voormiddag op die genoemde sewe-en-twintigste dag van September 1950, vir die afhandeling van sake.

PROCLAMATION
BY HIS HONOUR PETRUS IMKER HOOGENHOUT,
ADMINISTRATOR OF SOUTH WEST AFRICA.

No. 43 of 1950.]

WHEREAS by sub-section (2) of section *nineteen* of the South West Africa Constitution Act, 1925, of the Parliament of the Union of South Africa, it is provided that the First Sitting of any Session of the Legislative Assembly for the Territory of South West Africa, shall take place on such date as the Administrator may fix by proclamation;

AND WHEREAS it is expedient that the Legislative Assembly should be summoned to meet;

NOW, THEREFORE, under and by virtue of the power and authority in me vested, I do by this Proclamation summon the Legislative Assembly to meet on the twenty-seventh day of September, 1950, and I hereby declare that the First Sitting of the First Session of the Sixth Legislative Assembly shall be held at Windhoek at eleven o'clock in the forenoon on the said twenty-seventh day of September, 1950, for the dispatch of business.
