CUSTOMS ACT, 1955.

IMPOSITION OF AN ORDINARY DUMPING DUTY ON
HIGH TENSION SWITCHGEAR.

I, ERIC HENDRIK LOUW, Minister of Finance, in
terms of the powers vested in me by section eighty-three
of the Customs Act, No. 55 of 1955, hereby amend, as
from the date of publication of this notice, Government
Notice No. 223 of the 17th February, 1956, by the addition
after paragraph (ii) of item ex 119(a) of the following
paragraph:—

Goods.

"(iii) Completely assembled distribution
switchboards complete with circuit
breakers, whether oil or air insulated,
suitable for operation on systems hav-
ing nominal voltages from 1,000 volts
to 11,000 volts (where the nominal
voltage is the voltage between lines),
together with auxiliary equipment
such as cubicles, busbars, wiring,
instruments and meters, protection
equipment and potential and current
transformers.
