NOTE: An International certificate of vaccination against smallpox is valid for 3 years from date of vaccination.

Every South African citizen or person permanently resident in South West Africa, including the Republic of South Africa, who crosses the borders of South West Africa and visits Greece, Turkey, Russia, any country in Africa or any country between longitudes 30° and 180° shall on departure be in possession of a valid international certificate of vaccination against cholera as provided for in the International Sanitary Regulations Act, 1952 (Act 38 of 1952) in respect of himself, which shall be produced to the officer exercising health control at the place of his departure when requested thereto.

NOTE: An international certificate of vaccination against cholera is valid for six months from date of vaccination.
