The Deputy Administrator has been pleased to assent, in terms of section 27 of the South West Africa Constitution Act, 1968 (Act 39 of 1968) to the following Ordinance which is hereby published for general information in terms of section 29 of the said Act:-

MUNICIPAL AMENDMENT ORDINANCE, 1974.

(Assented to 10 July 1974.)
(English text signed by the Deputy Administrator.)
(Date of commencement 15 July 1974.)

ORDINANCE

To amend the Municipal Ordinance, 1963, so as to define the expression "sanitary services"; to provide that no person shall become a candidate in more than one ward at an election of councillors; to increase the amount of expenditure allowed in respect of elections; to provide that a council shall not be obliged to require security for the payment of charges, fees or rates due or which may become due to the council by the Suidwes-Afrika Water- en Elektrisiteitskorporasie (Eiendoms) Beperk in respect of the consumption of water, electricity or gas; to provide that a council may sell goods which have been found on the premises of a swimming bath and which have not been claimed; to provide that a council may redeem bursaries and loans applied for study at certain educational institutions; and to provide for incidental matters.

BE IT ORDAINED by the Legislative Assembly for the Territory of South West Africa, as follows:-

1. Section 1 of the Municipal Ordinance, 1963 (Ordinance 13 of 1963) — hereinafter referred to as the principal Ordinance — is hereby amended by the insertion after the definition of "sanitary convenience" of the following definition:

"sanitary services" includes sewerage services;".

2. Section 21 of the principal Ordinance is hereby amended by the addition of the following further proviso:

Amendment of section 21 of Ordinance 13 of 1963.

"Provided further that no person shall become a candidate in more than one ward at an election of councillors.".

3. Section 82 of the principal Ordinance is hereby amended by the substitution for paragraph (a) of subsection (1) of the following paragraph:

Amendment of section 82 of Ordinance 13 of 1963.

"(a) for each candidate four hundred rand and a further four rand for every one hundred enrolled voters over and above five hundred;".
