BYLAE

Definition

1. In this Proclamation, unless the context indicates otherwise, "territory" means the territory of South West Africa.

Amnesty and persons in respect of whom it applies

2. (1) No criminal proceedings shall after the date of commencement of this Proclamation be instituted or continued in any court of law against any person referred to in subsection (2) or (3), in respect of any criminal offence committed by such person in the territory or elsewhere at any time before the said date.

(2) The provisions of subsection (1) shall, subject to the provisions of subsection (3), apply only in respect of a person born in the territory or the spouse or child of such a person, who immediately before the date of commencement of this Proclamation was ordinarily resident at any place other than within the territory and who on or after the said date enters the territory at any point of entry specified in the Annexure or such other point of entry as may from time to time be designated by the Administrator-General and made known by notice in the *Official Gazette*, and to whom a document has been issued bearing an endorsement made at the time of such entry by a person in the government service designated by the Administrator-General for that purpose.

(3) The Administrator-General may in his discretion by notice in the *Official Gazette* direct that the provisions of subsection (1) shall, subject to such conditions as he may determine, apply to any person or category of persons other than a person referred to in subsection (2).

Short title

3. This Proclamation shall be called the Amnesty Proclamation, 1989.

Woordomskrywing

1. In hierdie Proklamasie, tensy uit die samehang anders blyk, beteken "gebied" die gebied Suidwes-Afrika.

Amnestie en persone ten opsigte van wie dit geld

2. (1) Geen strafregtelike geding word na die datum van inwerkingtreding van hierdie Proklamasie in enige geregshof teen enige persoon in subartikel (2) of (3) bedoel, ingestel of voortgesit nie ten opsigte van 'n misdryf wat deur sodanige persoon te enige tyd voor die bedoelde datum in die gebied of elders gepleeg is.

(2) Die bepalings van subartikel (1) is, behoudens die bepalings van subartikel (3), van toepassing slegs ten opsigte van 'n persoon gebore in die gebied, of die gade of kind van so 'n persoon, wat onmiddellik voor die datum van inwerkingtreding van hierdie Proklamasie op enige plek elders as binne die gebied gewoonlik woonagtig was en wat op of na die bedoelde datum die gebied binnekom by 'n binnekomspunt in die Aanhangel vermeld, of enige ander binnekomspunt wat van tyd tot tyd deur die Administrateur-generaal aangewys en by kennisgewing in die *Offisiële Koerant* bekend gemaak word, en aan wie 'n dokument uitgereik is waarop 'n endossement voorkom wat ten tye van sodanige binnekoms aangebring is deur 'n persoon in die regeringsdiens wat vir dié doel deur die Administrateur-generaal aangewys is.

(3) Die Administrateur-generaal kan na goeddunke by kennisgewing in die *Offisiële Koerant* gelas dat die bepalings van subartikel (1), onderworpe aan die voorwaardes wat hy bepaal, van toepassing is op 'n persoon of kategorie van persone anders as 'n persoon in subartikel (2) bedoel.

Kort titel

3. Hierdie Proklamasie heet die Proklamasie op Amnestie, 1989.
