PROMULGATION OF ACT OF THE NATIONAL ASSEMBLY

The following Act which has been passed by the National Assembly and signed by the President in terms of the Namibian Constitution is hereby published in terms of Article 56 of that Constitution.

No. 1 of 1991: Additional Appropriation Act, 1991.

Act No. 1, 1991

ADDITIONAL APPROPRIATION ACT, 1991

ACT

To appropriate additional amounts of money to meet the financial requirements of the State during the financial year ending 31 March 1991.

(Signed by the President on 20 March 1991)

BE IT ENACTED by the National Assembly of the Republic of Namibia, as follows:-

Appropriation of amounts of money for requirements of State. Subject to the provisions of the State Finance Act, 1982 (Act 1 of 1982), there are hereby appropriated for the financial requirements of the State during the financial year ending 31 March 1991, as a charge to the State Revenue Fund, the additional amounts of money shown in the Schedule.

Short title.

This Act shall be called the Additional Appropriation Act, 1991. Act No. 1, 1991
