## REGULATIONS MADE UNDER THE INCOME TAX ACT, 1981: STANDARD VALUE OF LIVESTOCK

The President has under section 99(1) of the Income Tax Act, 1981 (Act 24 of 1981) -

- (a) made the regulations set out in the Schedule; and
- (b) repealed Government Notice AG 47 of 1982.

### **SCHEDULE**

For the purposes of items (a)(ii), (c)(i) and (d)(i) of subparagraph (1) of paragraph 6 of Schedule 1 to the Income Tax Act, 1981 (Act 24 of 1981), and in relation to any year of assessment with regard to which the said Act is applicable, the standard value is the amount indicated against every class of livestock respectively:
