**PROMULGATION OF ACT OF
PARLIAMENT**

The following Act which has been passed by the Parliament and signed by the President in terms of the Namibian Constitution is hereby published in terms of Article 56 of that Constitution.

ACT

To amend the Social and Social Auxiliary Workers' Professions Act, 1993, so as to provide that only social workers and social auxiliary workers registered in terms of the Act shall be eligible as candidates for election at, or entitled to vote in, the first election of members of the Social and Social Auxiliary Workers' Board; and to provide for matters incidental thereto.

BE IT ENACTED by the Parliament of the Republic of Namibia, as follows:-

Amendment of section 5
of Act 22 of 1993.

1. Section 5 of the Social and Social Auxiliary Workers' Professions Act, 1993 (hereinafter referred to as the principal Act), is hereby amended by the addition of the following subsection:

“(6) Notwithstanding the provisions of this section, no person, including a person who, by virtue of section 50(1), is deemed to have been registered as a social worker, shall be eligible as a candidate for election at, or entitled to vote in, the first election of members of the Board contemplated in subsection (3), unless such person has been registered as a social worker or social auxiliary worker under the provisions of this Act by the Minister exercising such power by virtue of section 51.”

Amendment of section 48
of Act 22 of 1993.

2. Section 48 of the principal Act is hereby amended by the substitution for subsection (1) of the following subsection:

**SOCIAL AND SOCIAL AUXILIARY WORKERS'
PROFESSIONS AMENDMENT ACT, 1994**

“(1) The Minister may, on such conditions as he or she may deem fit, in writing delegate any power conferred upon him or her by this Act to the Permanent Secretary, excluding any power conferred by section [45] 46.”

Short title.

3. This Act shall be called the Social and Social Auxiliary Workers' Professions Amendment Act, 1994.
