**"FEES FOR BUILDING PLANS AND INSPECTIONS**

## (c) Dwellings under a self-help scheme:

In the case of a dwelling not exceeding 60m<sup>2</sup> under a self-help scheme to be erected on an erf zoned as "residential" with a density of not less than 250m<sup>2</sup> area per dwelling and to which no building value restriction is applicable:

For a dwelling not exceeding 40m<sup>2</sup> N\$20,00

For a dwelling exceeding 40m<sup>2</sup> but not exceeding 60m<sup>2</sup> N\$50,00

In this subparagraph, "self-help scheme" means a scheme provided by government or an institution to assist people who do not qualify for an ordinary housing loan from a bank or building society.

(d) Boundary wall or swimming pool: N\$50,00

## (2) INSPECTIONS:

(a) The fees prescribed under paragraph (1) include fees for a first inspection of every stage of the building operations required to be inspected and for the final inspection upon completion of the build-

ing: Provided that where, in relation to dwellings under a development scheme referred to in paragraph (1)(b), any such inspection is called for, not less than 10 dwellings are presented ready for inspection per attendance of the stage required to be inspected, failing which an inspection fee of N\$50 shall be payable for the inspection called for.

- (b) If for any reason not attributable to the employee of Council charged with the function of carrying out inspections, any stage of building operations required to be inspected for approval is not approved upon the first inspection, a fee of N\$50 shall be payable for each subsequent occasion such employee is required to attend at the building for inspecting that stage for approval.

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


