#### DECLARATION OF KATIMA MULILO (EXTENSION 8) TO BE AN APPROVED TOWNSHIP

In terms of section 13 of the Townships and Division of Land Ordinance, 1963 (Ordinance No. 11 of 1963), I hereby declare the area situated on Portion 12 of the farm Katima Mulilo Townlands No. 1328 in the Town Area of Katima Mulilo, Registration Division B, and represented by General Plan B134 (A422/99) to be an approved township.

concerned has been granted, are set forth in the Schedule below in terms of the said section 13.

**SCHEDULE**

**1. Name of township**

The township shall be called Katima Mulilo (Extension 8).

**2. Composition of township**

The township comprises 118 erven numbered 1861 to 1978 and streets as indicated on General Plan B134 (A422/99).

**3. Reservation of erf**

Erf 1978 is reserved for the Local Authority Council of Katima Mulilo for the purpose of an open space.

**4. Conditions of title**

The following conditions shall be registered in favour of the Local Authority Council of Katima Mulilo against the title deeds of all erven, except erf 1978 referred to in paragraph 3:

- “(a) The erf shall be used for residential purposes only.
- (b) The building value of a dwelling unit, including the outbuildings to be erected on the erf, shall be at least four times the prevailing valuation of the erf by the local authority.
- (c) There shall be no obstruction or deviation of any natural course of storm water over the erf without the written approval of the local authority.
- (d) The erf is subject to the reservation for the local authority of the right of access and use, without compensation, of the area three metres parallel with any boundary of such erf, for the construction and maintenance of local authority services in respect of water, sewerage, drainage, electricity and gas, which right includes the right to place on such erf temporarily any material that may be excavated during such operations on such erf or any adjacent erf.
- (e) If the erf has more than one street frontage, access to the erf shall be obtained from the street determined by the local authority.
- (f) No offensive trade whatsoever shall be established or conducted on the erf.

For the purpose of this item, ‘offensive trade’ means any of the business, trades, works or institutions mentioned in regulation 1(a) of the regulations promulgated under Government Notice No. 141 of 10 November 1926.

- (g) No cattle, pigs, goats, sheep, monkeys, beasts of prey or draught-animals shall be kept or allowed on the erf.”

The Regional Centre for Mapping of Resources for Development (RCMRD), an intergovernmental organization established under the auspices of the United Nations Economic Commission for Africa (UNECA), invites applications from suitable candidates for the posts of **Senior Cartographer** (One post) and **Finance Officer** (One Post). The details of the posts are as follows:

1. **Senior Cartographer** will work in the Department of Resource Mapping under the supervision of the Department's Director; and will be required to execute the following key duties:
  - (i) Prepare thematic and related graphical data layers for photolithographic reproduction and development of digital databases;
  - (ii) Develop relevant analogue and digital geo-referenced databases as needed by member States in formats that can be linked to national data archives;
  - (iii) Upgrade on a continuous basis the Centre's digital mapping facility to ensure that it supports the various projects at the Centre and in member States;
  - (iv) Programme and conduct training, participate in consultancy and research in cartography; and, provide the needed advice to member States in the application of new technologies in that field;
  - (v) Assist the Director of Resource Mapping in supervision of cartographic activities at the Centre and procurement of cartographic materials and equipment.

- . be fully aware of the trends of development in the technologies of image mapping and digital cartographic, and able to assimilate the new developments into the work programme of the department of Resource Mapping;
  - . posses at least a good degree in an area of geomatic or geographic science and postgraduate qualifications in cartography and GIS or other related fields;
  - . Have at least 8 years experience of working in a reputable mapping agency; and, good experience in teaching and international exposure will be added advantages;
  - . Be above 35 years of age.
2. **Finance Officer** will be responsible to the Director General for all accounting and financial functions and will be expected to perform the following duties:

  - (iv) Ensure prompt production of annual accounts and financial reports for auditing and publication as required by the Centre's financial regulations;
