Increased demand from own clients requires expansion of the aircraft fleet and versatility in respect of aircraft of aircraft types used. All the additional aircraft will be leased from private owners except for 2 x C210 which will be purchased.

5.2 The Wilderness Safaris Group of companies accommodate in excess of 50 000.00 mainly foreign tourists in their lodges in Southern Africa per annum.

5.3 Since the grant of this licence in 1997 the applicant actively marketed the idea of visiting more than one lodge by air transfer on a single visit to Namibia and was successful to the extent that an exponential growth for air transfers between lodges and other places of interest in Namibia is being experienced.

5.4 For these reasons applicant needs to expand its fleet of aircraft substantially to meet the demand created in the Wilderness Safari Group of companies.
