In terms of Section 13 of the Townships and Division of Land Ordinance, 1963 (Ordinance No. 11 of 1963), I -

- (a) declare the area situated on Portion 19, of the Farm Ondangwa Town and Townlands No. 882, Registration Division "A" in the Oshana Region, as represented by the General Plan No. A 289 (S.G No. A470/2013), to be an approved township; and
- (b) set out in the Schedule the conditions subject to which the application for permission to establish the township concerned has been granted.

The township shall be called Ondangwa Extension 20.

2. Composition of township:

The township comprises 279 erven numbered 4339 to 4617 and the remainder streets as indicated on General Plan A 289.

3. Reservation of erven:

The following erven are reserved for the Local Authority:

- for Substation purposes: Erf 4369
- for Pump Station purposes: Erf 4492
- for Public Open Space purposes: Erven 4616 and 4617.

4. Conditions of title:

The following conditions shall be registered in favour of the Local Authority against the title deeds of all erven, except the erven referred to in paragraph 3:

- (a) the erf shall only be used or occupied for purposes which are in accordance with, and the use or occupation of the erf shall at all times be subject to, the provisions of the Ondangwa Town Planning Scheme prepared and approved in terms of the Town Planning Ordinance, 1954 (Ordinance 18 of 1954);
- (b) the building value of the main building, including the outbuildings, on the erf shall be at least four times the prevailing valuation of the erf.
