AMENDMENT OF GOVERNMENT NOTICE NO. 114 OF 30 APRIL 2020 AND ALCOHOL-BASED HAND SANITISERS REGULATIONS SET OUT IN SCHEDULE TO THAT NOTICE: STANDARDS ACT, 2005

Under section 34(1)(d) of the Standards Act, 2005 (Act No. 18 of 2005), after consultation with the Namibian Standards Institution, I have amended -

- (a) the Government Notice No. 114 of 30 April 2020 by the substitution for paragraph (b) of the following paragraph:
  - "(b) section 20(6) of that Act, I declare that compliance with NAMS/SANS 490, published under General Notice No. 240 of 1 July 2021, is compulsory for purposes of that section.";
- (b) the Alcohol-Based Hand Sanitisers Regulations set out in the Schedule to the Government Notice No. 114 of 30 April 2020 by the substitution -
  - (i) for the definition of "prescribed fee" of the following definition:

""prescribed fee" means the relevant fee payable by the applicant to NSI for service rendered or to be rendered in accordance with these regulations, as published in the *Gazette* from time to time;";

- (ii) for paragraph (a) of regulation 2 of the following paragraph:
- "(a) declare that compliance with NAMS/SANS 490 published under General Notice No. 240 of 1 July 2021 is compulsory in terms of section 20(6) of the Act;".
