FEES PAYABLE TO THE PHARMACY COUNCIL OF NAMIBIA IN TERMS OF SECTION 28 OF THE PHARMACY ACT, 2004

The President of the Pharmacy Council of Namibia under subsection (3) of section 28 of the Pharmacy Act, 2004 (Act No. 9 of 2004), makes known that the Pharmacy Council with the written approval of the Minister of Health and Social Services, -

- (a) has determined the fees payable to the Council in terms of subsection (1) of that section as set out in the Schedule; and
- (b) repeals General Notice No. 497 of 9 December 2020.

SCHEDULE

Definitions

1. In this Schedule, a word or an expression to which a meaning has been assigned in the Pharmacy Act, 2004 (Act No. 9 of 2004) has that meaning, and unless the context indicates otherwise -

"additional qualification" means an additional qualification registered under section 31 of the Act;

"specialist" means any person in whose name a speciality is registered;

"speciality" means any speciality registered under section 31 of the Act; and

"the Act" means the Pharmacy Act, 2004 (Act No. 9 of 2004).
