AMENDMENT OF REGULATIONS RELATING TO IMMIGRATION CONTROL REGULATIONS: IMMIGRATION CONTROL ACT, 1993

Under section 58(1) of the Immigration Control Act, 1993 (Act No. 7 of 1993), I amended the regulations published under Government Notice No. 134 of 29 July 1994 set out in the Schedule.

SCHEDULE

Definitions

1. In these regulations "the Regulations" means the Regulations under the Immigration Control Act, 1993 published under Government Notice No. 134 of 29 July 1994, as amended by Government Notices Nos. 82 of 15 April 2008, 133 of 1 July 2010, 145 of 8 September 2014, 138 of 13 July 2018, 8 of 21 January 2020, 153 of 19 July 2021 and 327 of 29 September 2023.

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Amendment of regulation 1 of Regulations

- 2. Regulation 1 of the regulations is amended by –
- (a) the insertion after the definition of "commencement" of the following definition:

""electronic border management system" means the information and communication technology system used for collecting, processing and presenting information in order to support operational, management, and decision making performance in carrying out the immigration function;"; and

(b) the insertion after the definition of "occupation" of the following definition:

""recognised biometrics" means an identification method, used by immigration officials through the electronic border management system, which uses the unique physical or behavioural characteristics of individuals, which include -

- (a) facial photographs;
- (b) fingerprints or handprints;
- (c) height and weight measurements; or
- (d) other appropriate means,

to recognise and verify their identity;".

Substitution of regulation 2 of Regulations

3. The Regulations are amended by the substitution for regulation 2 of the following regulation:

"Declaration by persons seeking to enter Namibia

2. (1) A person entering Namibia, excluding a returning resident, shall make a declaration in the form of Annexure 'A' ('Arrival Form'), to be completed –

- (a) manually by the declarant and signed by him or her;
- (b) electronically by the declarant and signed by way of electronic signature or recognised biometrics; or
- (c) electronically by the declarant, printed out and signed by him or her,

and shall be presented to the immigration officer on arrival at the specific port of entry.

(2) A person entering Namibia who is suspected of being a prohibited immigrant shall make a declaration in the form of Annexure 'B', to be completed –

- (a) manually by the declarant and signed by him or her;
- (b) electronically by the declarant and signed by him or her by way of electronic signature or recognised biometrics; or
- (c) electronically by the declarant, printed out and signed by him or her,

and shall be presented to the immigration officer on arrival at the specific port of entry.

(3) If a person is unable to complete the declaration referred to in subregulation (1) or (2), an immigration officer may question such a person through an interpreter and may complete the declaration or cause it to be completed on behalf of such person and shall thereupon require and enable such person to sign or thumbprint it.

(4) A visitor's entry permit shall be imprinted in the passport of the person entering Namibia, in the form of Annexure 'C'.

(5) Subregulation (1) applies to a returning resident who is a Namibian citizen or a permanent resident of Namibia, where the electronic border management system is not functioning at the time of processing that person's entry into Namibia.".
