AMENDMENT OF REGULATIONS RELATING TO MINIMUM REQUIREMENTS OF STUDY OF MEDICAL PHYSICIST, REGISTRATION OF INTERNS, RESTORATION OF NAME TO REGISTER AND SCOPE OF PRACTICE OF MEDICAL PHYSICIST: HEALTH PROFFESIONS ACT, 2024

Under section 91 of the Health Professions Act, 2024 (Act No. 16 of 2024), I have on the recommendation of the Health Professions Council of Namibia which was made after that Council consulted with the Medical and Dental Board of Namibia, amended the Regulations relating to the minimum requirements of study of Medical Physicist, registration of interns, restoration of name to register and scope of practice of Medical Physicist published in Government Notice No. 52 of 24 February 2020, as set out in the Schedule.

SCHEDULE

Definition

1. In these regulations “the Regulations” means the regulations relating to the minimum requirements of study of Medical Physicist, registration of interns, restoration of name to register and scope of practice of Medical Physicist published in Government Notice No. 52 of 24 February 2020.

Amendment of regulation 2 of Regulations

2. Regulation 2 of the Regulations is amended by the substitution for subregulation (1) of the following subregulation:

- “(1) The Council may register a person as a medical physicist if that person holds –
- (a) a Bachelors degree in Medical Physics successfully completed after full time study for a period of not less than three years;
 - (b) a Bachelor of Science degree completed after full time study of not less than three years, held conjointly with a Bachelor of Science (Honours) degree in Medical Physics or a Master of Science degree in Medical Physics or a Doctor of Philosophy degree in Medical Physics completed after full time study for a period of not less than one year; or
 - (c) a qualification which is equivalent to those stated in paragraphs (a) and (b).”.
