DECLARATION OF AREA AS CONSERVANCY: EKANGO LYOMONGWA CONSERVANCY: NATURE CONSERVATION ORDINANCE, 1975

In terms of subsection (2) of section 24A of the Nature Conservation Ordinance, 1975 (Ordinance No. 4 of 1975), I declare the area, of which the geographical boundaries are set out in the Schedule, as Ekango Lyomongwa Conservancy.

A map of Ekango Lyomongwa Conservancy and other relevant documents required in terms of subsection (1) of that section, lie open for inspection during office hours at office number D3-D18, second floor, Directorate of Wildlife and National Parks, Ministry of Environment, Forestry and Tourism, corner of Kenneth Kaunda Street and Robert Mugabe Avenue, Windhoek.

SCHEDULE

DESCRIPTION OF GEOGRAPHIC BOUNDARIES OF EKANGO LYOMONGWA CONSERVANCY, OSHIKOTO REGION

The Ekango Lyomongwa Conservancy is situated in the political constituency of Omuntele in the Oshikoto Region. The communal conservancy covers an area of 132 651.94 hectares and it will be subdivided into different zones or sections.

The point of beginning is at Point 1 which is situated at the fence of Etosha National Park and the point of beginning for King Nehale Conservancy boundaries. From Point 1 the boundary moves in the north-eastern direction alongside Okalonga and King Nehale Conservancy boundary line to Point 2. From Point 2 the boundary turns to the northern direction alongside Okalonga and King Nehale Conservancy boundary line to Point 3. From Point 3 the boundary moves alongside Okalonga through Othadhambuku moving in the north direction towards Point 4 which is located at Etopelyombidhi. From Point 4 the boundary moves in the north-eastern direction to Point 5. From Point 5 the boundary moves towards the northern direction to reach Point 6 at Etambo. From Point 6 at Etambo the boundary moves slightly on the north-east towards Oshalongo at Point 7 where it reaches north-east of the constituency boundaries of Omuntele and Onyaanya Constituencies at Point 8. From Point 8 the boundary moves along the Onyaanya and Omuntele Constituencies boundary line in the south west direction to reach Point 9. From Point 9 the boundary moves in a north-west direction to reach Point 10. From Point 10 the boundary moves to the south-west direction to Point 11. From Point 11 the boundary moves toward the south and then to the south-west direction to Point 12. From Point 12 the boundary moves toward the west and then in a north-eastern direction to Point 13. From Point 13 the boundary moves in a north-north west direction and heads off in the northern direction to Point 14. From Point 14 the boundary moves towards the north-west direction to Point 15. From Point 15 the boundary moves in the north-west direction to Point 16 then the boundary moves in the north-west and west direction to Point 17. From Point 17 the boundary moves in a south-west direction to Point 18 at Onkani. From Point 18 the boundary moves in the south west direction to Point 19 at Epumbu. From Point 19 the boundary moves toward the south-west direction to Point 20 which is located at Omutomboli. From Point 20 the boundary moves in the south-west direction to Point 21 which is still in Omutomboli. From Omutomboli the boundary line moves in the south west direction to Iitota at Point 22. From Point 22 the boundary moves in the western direction and makes a curve in the south western direction to Point 23. From Point 23 the boundary moves in the south west direction to Uuthima wa Andreas at Point 24. From Point 24 the boundary moves toward the south-east direction to Point 25 at Ohongo. From Point 25 the boundary moves towards south direction to Point 26 at Okuma River and moves in the south-west direction to Point 27 at the flood station. From Point 27 the boundary moves towards south-west direction to Point 28 at the corner of Etosha National Park, then the boundary moves in an eastern direction to the point of beginning at Point 1.
