2. Composition of township

The township comprises 323 erven numbered 4281 to 4603 and the remainder streets as indicated on General Plan J141 (SG. No. A 40/2021).

3. Reservation of erven

The following erven are reserved for the local authority:

- (a) Erven 4592 to 4596 are reserved for private open space purposes; and
- (b) Erven 4597 to 4603 for street purposes.

4. Conditions of title

CLOSING OF A PORTION OF MAIN ROAD 76: DISTRICT OF SWAKOPMUND

In terms of section 22(2) of the Roads Ordinance, 1972 (Ordinance 17 of 1972), it is hereby made known that the Minister has under section 22(1)(c) of the said Ordinance; in the district of Swakopmund, closed a portion of main road 76 described in the Schedule and as shown on sketch-map P2442 by the symbols A-B-C-D-E-F.
