BYLAE.

REGULASIES.

1. (a) Met ingang vanaf die negentiende dag van September 1949, is die pari-waarde van die Suid-Afrikaanse pond 38·4 grein fyn goud.

(b) Genoemde pari-waarde word geag ook op die agtiende dag van September 1949 te gegeld het.

2. (a) Geen bankinstelling wat volgens die by Goewermentskenisgewing No. 163 van die drie-en-twintigste dag van Januarie 1948, afgekondigde Deviese-beheerregulasies, soos gewysig, 'n gemagtigde handelaar is, mag enigeen van sy besigheidsplekke te enige tyd op die negentiende dag van September 1949, oop laat wees nie.

(b) Niemand mag op genoemde datum enige transaksie namens of ten behoeve van so'n bankinstelling met enige ander persoon dan so'n bankinstelling aangaan nie.

3. (a) Niemand mag te eniger tyd op die negentiende dag van September 1949 'n effektebeurs oop laat wees nie.

(b) Geen effektemakelaar soos in artikel *een* van die Wet op Beheer van Effektebeurse, 1947 (Wet No. 7 van 1947) omskryf, en geen effekte- of aandeelhandelaar soos aldus omskryf, mag op genoemde datum, onverskillig of dit al dan nie ten behoeve van 'n ander persoon is nie, enige effekte of aandele, soos aldus omskryf, koop of verkoop of op 'n ander manier daarmee handel nie.

4. Iemand wat 'n bepaling van regulasie *twee* of *drie* oortree, is aan 'n misdryf skuldig en by skuldigbevinding strafbaar met 'n boete van hoogstens vyfduisend pond of met gevangenisstraf vir 'n tydperk van hoogstens vyf jaar, of met beide sodanige boete en sodanige gevangenisstraf.

5. Die negentiende dag van September 1949 word geag 'n openbare feesdag volgens die „Openbare Feesdagen Wet”, 1910 (Wet No. 3 van 1910) te wees vir die doel van die nakoming van enige verpligting, die uitoefening van enige reg of die verrigting van enige handeling wat op of nie later nie dan genoemde datum nagekom, uitgeoefen of verrig dien te word, en wat, as gevolg van die bepalings van regulasie *twee* of *drie*, dit nie doenlik is om op genoemde datum na te kom, uit te oefen of te verrig nie.

PROCLAMATION

BY HIS EXCELLENCY THE RIGHT HONOURABLE GIDEON BRAND VAN ZYL, A MEMBER OF HIS MAJESTY'S MOST HONOURABLE PRIVY COUNCIL, DOCTOR OF LAWS, GOVERNOR-GENERAL OF THE UNION OF SOUTH AFRICA.

Under the powers vested in me by section *nine* of the Currency and Exchanges Act, 1933 (Act No. 9 of 1933), I do hereby make the regulations set forth in the Annexure to this Proclamation.

ANNEXURE.

REGULATIONS.

1. (a) As from the nineteenth day of September, 1949, the par value for the South African pound shall be 38·4 grains of fine gold.

(b) The said par value shall be deemed to have obtained also on the eighteenth day of September, 1949.

2. (a) No banking institution which is an authorized dealer in terms of the Exchange Control Regulations published under Government Notice No. 163 of the twenty-third day of January, 1948, as amended, shall keep open any of its places of business at any time on the nineteenth day of September, 1949.

(b) No person shall on the said date enter into any transaction in the name or on behalf of any such banking institution with any person other than such a banking institution.

3. (a) No person shall at any time on the nineteenth day of September, 1949, keep open any stock exchange.

(b) No stockbroker, as defined in section *one* of the Stock Exchanges Control Act, 1947 (Act No. 7 of 1947) and no dealer in stocks or shares, as so defined, shall on the said date, whether or not on behalf of any other person, buy or sell or otherwise deal in any stocks or shares as so defined.

4. Any person who contravenes any provision of regulation *two* or *three* shall be guilty of an offence and liable on conviction to a fine not exceeding five thousand pounds or to imprisonment for a period not exceeding five years or to both such fine and imprisonment.

5. The nineteenth day of September, 1949, shall be deemed to be a public holiday in terms of the Public Holidays Act, 1910 (Act No. 3 of 1910), for the purpose of the carrying out of any obligation, the exercise of any right or the doing of any act, which is to be carried out, exercised or done on or not later than the said date, and which, as the result of the provisions of regulations *two* or *three*, it is not practicable to carry out, exercise or do on the said date.
