REGULATIONS SURVIVING IN TERMS OF

Health Professions Act 16 of 2024

section 95(10)

Maximum Fine that Council or Professional Conduct Committee May Impose

Government Notice 19 of 2018

(GG 6527)

came into force on date of publication: 15 February 2018

Note that GG 6527 was initially numbered incorrectly as GG 6528.

A corrected version was subsequently issued.

These regulations were made in terms of section 56 read with section 42(1)(d) of the Social Work and Psychology Act 6 of 2004, which was repealed by the Health Professions Act 16 of 2024.

Pursuant to section 95(10) of the Health Professions Act 16 of 2024,
they are deemed to have been made under that Act.

The Government Notice which publishes these regulations notes that they were
made on the recommendation of the Social Work and Psychology Council of Namibia.
It also repeals GN 157/2014 (GG 5559).

Definitions

1. In these regulations a word or expression to which a meaning has been assigned in the Act has that meaning and, unless the context indicates otherwise -

“the Act” means the Social Work and Psychology Act, 2004 (Act No. 6 of 2004).

Maximum fine that may be imposed by Council or professional conduct committee

2. Under section 42(1)(d) of the Act, the Council or the professional conduct committee may impose a fine not exceeding the amount of N\$200,000.00 per charge.
